Doctors To Learn Of Atomic Hurts

WASHINGTON, —(IP)—The go ernment will start this spring to prepare doctors across the nation to treat atomic-war injuring a mong civilians.

The Atomic Energy commission announced that a series of one-week courses will be held for selected members of the mdical profession, who in turn will instruct physicians, dentists and nurses in local areas."

The agency said it had prepared the program with the help of the National Security Resources board, which is the government's chief civil defense planning group and the General Services administration, which has the task of blueprinting wartime disaster relief.
