Judge Penalizes Photographer For Court Room Flash

LOS ANGELES, Jan. 18 — (AP)—A news photographer was sent to jail for five days Wednesday and fined \$100 for taking a picture in the courtroom of Superior Judge Paul Nourse.

The judge swore himself in as a witness, then delivered the decision. Perry Fowler, of the Evening Herald and Express, was the photographer.

Fowler snapped a picture of the crowd attending a hearing. Court was adjourned and Judge Nourse was leaving the courtroom when the flash of the bulb attracted his attention. He returned to the bench, re-convened court and cited Fowler for contempt.

Then, turning witness, he testified that he was still in the courtroom at the time. Fowler admitted taking the picture, declaring he did it on orders from his city desk. Bailiff James Chambers testified he had warned Fowler not to use his camera in the court.

Picture-taking in superior courtrooms is at the discretion of individual judges.

Canyonville Man Inventor Of New Type Can Opener

Robert Shaffer, secretary of the Canyonville Bible academy at Canyonville, has been busy in his spare time the past few months working on a new invention for which he has applied for a patent.

In an interview, Shaffer said the invention is a simple and practical tool for opening canned liquids, such as fruit and vegetable juices, canned milk, oil, jelly glasses, friction top lids and beverages. It also has a screw driver which acts as a gauge and stabilizer making it extra convenient to have in the kitchen.

Shaffer made a trip to Los Angeles in October to investigate production of the can opener. He was successful in locating a manufacturing company who could do the entire job.

About three weeks ago he made

another trip to Los Angeles and watched the employees of the company making the gadget. He was surprised to see all the processes there are for a simple little gadget like a can opener. The procedure begins with the stamping of the pattern on steel, heat-treating the metal, grinding the screw driver in, putting it

through a tumbling process to take all sharp edges off, nickle plating, metal ferrule for end of handle, make, drill and paint handle, print display card and mount on card. One rarely thinks of all these different operations while using an opener for canned liquids, he said.

Shaffer says the chief purpose

of the can opener is to replace dangerous tools for opening canned liquids. He got the idea from watching Mrs. Shaffer open cans of milk and juices for their two small children, Roger and Adele, and using ice picks and butcher knives. He went to work in the C.B.A. workshop and made a hand sample.

He plans to establish a sales office and make distribution from Canyonville for the present time. He will later contact and sell through larger companies on a contract basis. The opener should be on sale locally from 60 to 90 days, he said. It will sell for a price under 50 cents. Part of the proceeds will go into

improving C.B.A. Shaffer's hobby is taking movies with his 16mm camera, so for his own interest he plans to make a short illustrated film showing the improvements of the new opener over the old ones.

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
