Knowledge-Seeking Savant Joins Baby Gorillas

SAN DIEGO, Calif. — (AP) — A famous scientist has joined three baby gorillas here in the hope they could learn something from each other.

The scientist is Dr. Robert M. Yerkes, professor emeritus of psychology at Yale university.

The gorillas are Albert, Bata and Bouba, late of French equatorial Africa. They are the youngest gorillas in captivity in this country, their ages ranging from about nine months to one year.

Yerkes, famed in the field of mental and physical behavior of

anthropoid apes, plans to spend several months studying the three gorillas at the San Diego zoo.

He said he would try to teach the gorillas to talk or, at least to use symbolic sounds as a basis for further study.

Oregon Liquor Revenue Distribution Made

SALEM. — (AP) — The state department has distributed more than \$200,000 in liquor receipts to counties and cities.

Of the total, \$61,711 came from privilege taxes on alcoholic beverages for the last three months of 1934.

Other liquor tax money distributed included \$210,000. Of this amount, \$52,500 went into the state general fund, and the rest to counties and cities.

Willis Mahoney Replies To \$5,000 Suit On Note

PORTLAND, Jan. 27. — (AP) — Willis E. Mahoney, one-time candidate for U. S. senator and a prosecutor in the Japanese war crimes trials, says an unpaid bill for attorney fees cancels out a promissory note on which he has been sued.

Last fall Joseph L. Fearey, attorney for a collection agency, sued Mahoney in circuit court here on a \$5,000 note dating back to 1933, given to Scott Bullitt of Seattle and later assigned to Bullitt's daughter.

Mahoney's answer, on file here, says that he performed legal services worth \$5,000 for the father and daughter and never was paid.

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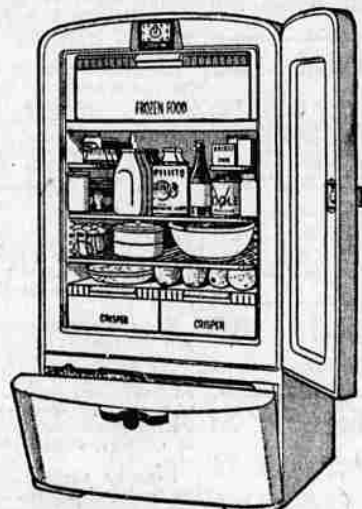
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
