Sept. 1-Oct. 31	Salmon not less than twenty inches.	Main Umpqua, excl. of tributaries, other than those mentioned above, EXCEPT: Mill Creek and portions of Elk & Calapooia Creeks. (See below).

NOTE: Jack salmon (under 20") may be taken only under regulations pertaining to trout and must be included in the bag limit for trout as shown above.

Bag limits of salmon and steelhead over 20" must be counted in the aggregate at all times, including the annual bag limit of twenty such fish.

Each salmon and steelhead over 20 inches in length in possession must be represented by a punch and appropriate data on the Salmon & Steelhead Annual Limit Card.

Closed to steelhead angling, March 1 through April 30—all waters.

Closed to salmon angling during the periods June 1 through August 31, and November 1 through April 14—all waters above highway 38 bridge at Scottsburg.

Closed to sturgeon angling the entire year—all waters.
