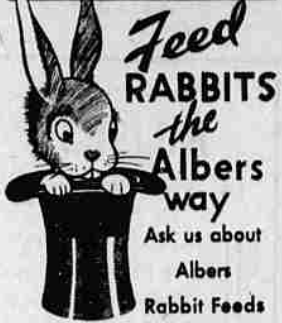


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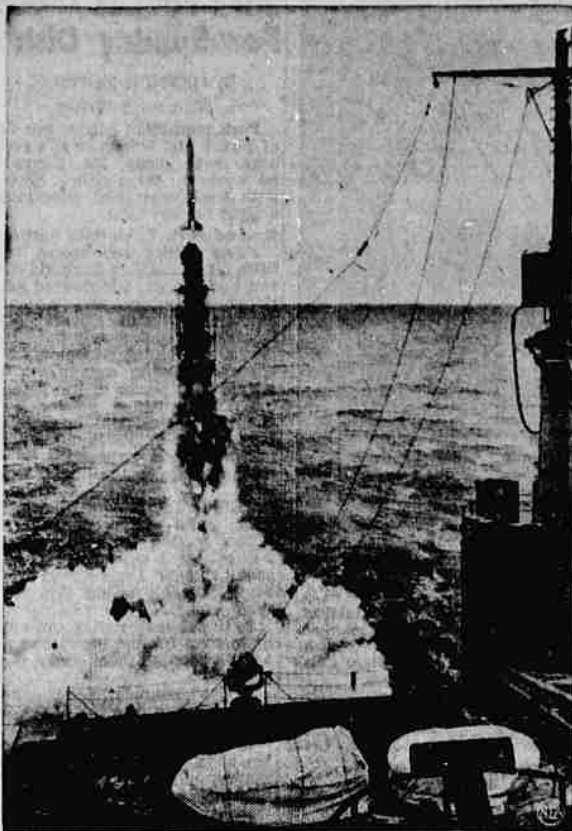

School Addition Myrtle Creek Plan

Bids for a new elementary school building and a four room addition to the existing high school building will be opened by the Myrtle Creek board of education at its meeting next Wednesday evening.

The elementary building will consist of a 15-classroom edifice which will handle the present elementary enrollment now on double shift in the southern Douglas county city.

Bids for a similar building were called for last October but the lowest bid was greater than the funds available for its construction. Since that time the voters of District 19c, Myrtle Creek and vicinity, approved a \$95,000 bond issue to supplement their building funds. A lively interest by contractors is anticipated in the bidding, according to Supt. M. C. Diller.

The new plant completed will accommodate 1035 pupils, which is the present enrollment.

The district has just completed a \$22,000 addition to the gymnasium.

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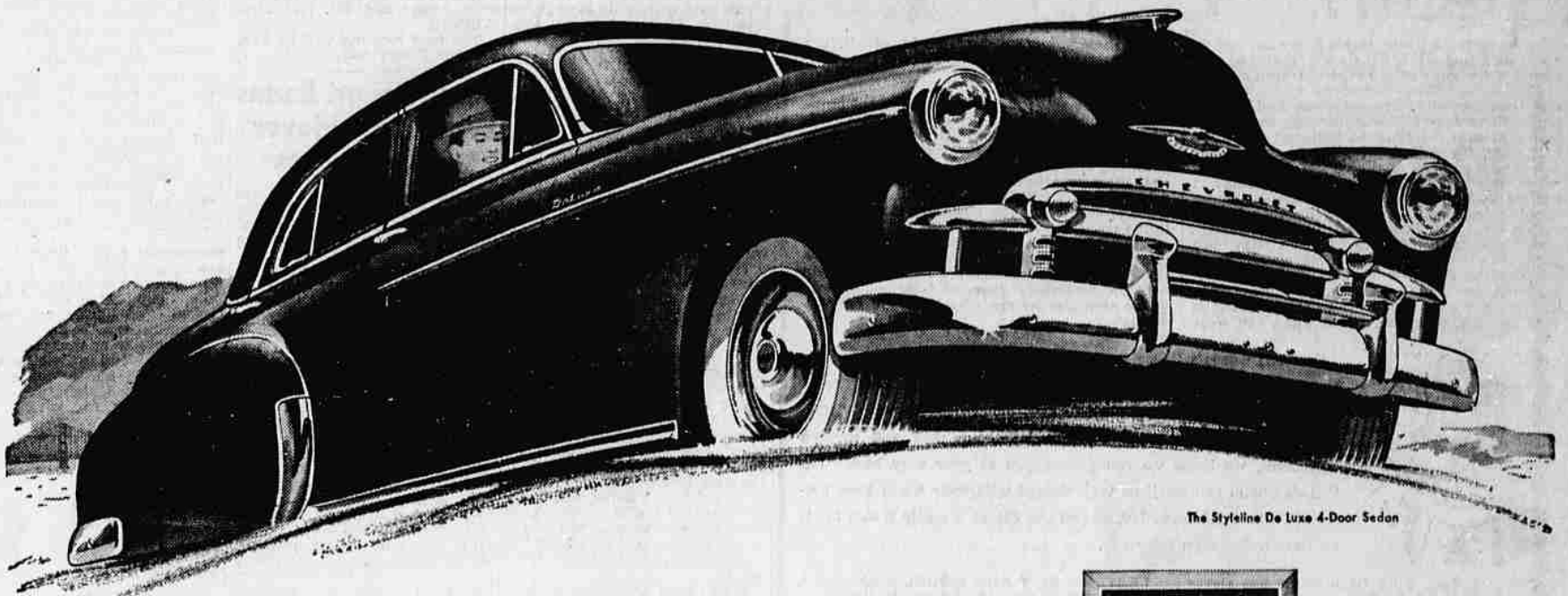
