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Actress Asks Probation On Drunk Driving Count

LOS ANGELES, Feb. 11 — (AP) — Actress Jean Wallace applied for probation today on her conviction of drunkenness and driving while intoxicated last Christmas eve. She was convicted yesterday.

Tearfully she asked Municipal Judge R. Morgan Galbreth for a probation investigation before sentence. The court agreed and set Feb. 28 for a probation-sentence hearing.

The judge then ordered Miss Wallace, 25, divorced wife of actor Franchot Tone, to surrender her driver's license to the court clerk, which she did.

Arresting officers testified that after her automobile whacked a parked car they discovered she was wearing only lace panties and a red coat. Miss Wallace claimed the policeman told her they wouldn't have arrested her if she had been "nice" to them. They denied her accusations.

Fat Men's Club Hits Snag In Reducing Contest

ASTORIA, Feb. 11 — (AP) — The 11 Astorians who formed a fat men's club to see who could lose the most weight in 40 days wound up their contest Friday in a statistical impasse.

They can't decide who ought to get the \$110 prize. The problem seems to be this:

It's easier for the very fat ones to shed pounds. Which should rate higher: a man who lost a lot, but was so rotund to start with that he still measures considerably outsize? Or a man who lost less, but got down to his normal weight in the process?

President Joe Garcia suggested dividing each man's poundage losses into his height. But the other chunky citizens rejected that.

It all got so complicated that the club postponed its weighing-out for another week, and appointed a committee of five physicians to work out a system.

10 Rescued After Crash Of Plane

WHITEHORSE, Y.T., Feb. 10 — (AP) — Ten men, stranded for three nights on a treeless Yukon mountain side, were ready to begin the arduous trek back to their home base today after a daring jump by six para-rescue troops.

The parachutists circled the marooned airmen for nearly an hour yesterday before spotting the wreckage of the crashed plane, then plummeted earthward. All landed safely within 300 yards of their target.

A short time later, another royal Canadian Air force Dakota (Canadian equivalent of the U.S.A.F. C-47) dropped pup tents and half a cord of firewood to the huddled party.

The 10 men, five U.S. airmen and five Canadian soldiers, were aboard a C-47 which crashed Tuesday night during the two-week-old search for a C-54 carrying 44 persons.

Flour Mill At Astoria Lays Off Many Employees

ASTORIA, Feb. 11 — (AP) — The Pillsbury flour mill laid off 40 percent of its employees, blaming the worst flour market in 30 years.

B. J. Greer, Los Angeles, division president of the firm, said the loss of export markets and high rail rates are forcing Northwest flour mills to operate at partial capacity. One of the worst problems, he said, is the loss of North China markets.

The mill here will operate at half capacity, running only one milling unit on a four-or five-day schedule. The working force was ordered cut from 96 men to 55 or 60.

Greer also complained about the deterioration of the mill property, owned by the port of Astoria. The port said it lacked funds to keep the property fully maintained.
