KLAMATH FALLS, March 6.—(P)—An elderly couple, driving home with their son and daughter-in-law from the latter's wedding, were seriously injured in an overturning car yesterday.

Donald Ackley, Willamette university student, and the former Doris Jean Stuart, Kittinging, Pa., had been married Saturday in Reno, Nev.

The Ackleys live in Brookings, Ore. Ackley, who was driving when the accident occurred, is a retired Bend lumberman.
