### Boy Scouts Plan For Jamboree Set At Valley Forge

The quota for the National Boy Scout jamboree, to be held at Valley Forge, Pennsylvania this July, is rapidly being filled in this area, according to Oregon Trail council headquarters in Eugene. Approximately one boy from each troop and senior scout unit will have an opportunity to make the trip, 150 places at the jamboree having been assigned to the Oregon trail council, which includes Lincoln, Benton, Lane, Douglas, Coos and Curry counties.

The boys from this area will travel by special train, and will be under the constant supervision of experienced adult scouts. The entire trip for the boys from the Northwest will take about 23 days, of which seven will be spent at the encampment at Valley Forge. The jamboree will extend over July Fourth, and it is expected that President Truman will make his Independence day speech to the 40,000 Boy Scouts who will attend this historic scouting event.

**Mortgage Foreclosure To Meet Judgment Ordered**

Lew Duguid was awarded judgment for \$150 plus interest and costs from Agnes G. and Arvin L. Huntly Tuesday in circuit court in an order signed by Judge Carl E. Wimberly.

The amount is alleged to be due on a promissory note, for which the defendant Agnes G. Huntly delivered her indenture of mortgage upon property described as lot one, block three, Crowl's addition, Canyonville.

The order also specifies that the mortgage, assigned to the plaintiff, is a first and prior lien against the premises; that the mortgage be foreclosed, that the property be sold by the sheriff and that the proceeds be applied to the costs of the sale and to the satisfaction of the judgment.

**Suit Filed To Recover On Promissory Note**

Otto W. Heider has filed suit in circuit court for \$1,510, with interest and costs, from J. E. and Evelyn Shaw, husband and wife. The amount is alleged due on a promissory note.

Heider further asks that the court foreclose his mortgage on the Shaw premises, located in the Roseburg and ha he proceeds be apptSHR Home Orchard tract, which the defendants Shaw delivered to the plaintiffs to secure payment on the note. Plaintiff also asks that the premises be sold by the sheriff and that the proceeds be applied to the satisfaction of the judgment.

In another money suit, State Unemployment Compensation commission demands judgment for \$51.99, plus interest and costs from Fred C. Reece, doing business as Roseburg Paint shop for alleged non-payment of required contributions.
