Lewis' Plan For Mutual Aid Pact Meets Disfavor

PITTSBURGH, March 10. — (AP) — President Philip Murray of the CIO United Steelworkers has rejected a John L. Lewis proposal for a mutual aid pact for common defense.

The rejection was included in a letter to the United Mine Workers' chieftain acknowledging Lewis' return of the \$500,000 check which the steelworkers sent the UMW for strike aid.

"Your proposal to negotiate a mutual aid pact for common defense has been considered by the executive board of the United Steelworkers of America. It is the unanimous view of our board, in which I join, that no useful purpose would be served by concluding any formal arrangement for such a pact."

The United Steelworkers of America, in conjunction with the CIO, will always make its resources available, as it did in your recent struggle, for every necessary and worthy defense of organized labor. The same is true of the CIO and of all its affiliated unions.

PROBE BEGINS

Senator's Charge Of Red Affiliation Brings 'Liar' Reply From U. S. Worker

WASHINGTON, March 10. — (AP) — Senator McCarthy (R-Wis.) charged Wednesday that Dorothy Kenyon, whom he identified as a State department employee, "has affiliated with at least 28 Communist front organizations."

She promptly called him a "liar." The State department also denied McCarthy's statement before a Senate committee that Miss Kenyon is now with the department as an American representative on a United Nations commission. Her three year term expired in December, the department said, adding that the U.N. job had been her only connection with the department.

The 62-year-old Miss Kenyon, a former New York City judge who is now practicing law there, accused McCarthy of "taking cowardly refuge in his congressional immunity to smear innocent people."

She said she had fought Russian delegates in the U.N. "for years."

McCarthy made the accusation before a senate foreign relations subcommittee at the opening of an inquiry into McCarthy's charges that a Communist spy ring is operating in the State department.

The hearing got off to an uproarious start with Chairman Tydings (D-Md.) promising McCarthy: "You are going to get one of the most complete investigations in the history of this country."

81 People Named
In the Senate recently, McCarthy detailed the cases of 81 persons he said are bad security risks. He named no names but said they either now or formerly were in the State department.

Presenting his first case to the subcommittee, McCarthy said: "Let us take the case of Dorothy Kenyon. This lady, according to the latest issue of the official registry of the U. S. government, is on the commission on the status of women, U. S. member of the commissions of the economic and social council, U. S. mission to the United Nations, Department of State. Her salary is \$12,000 a year."

"This lady has been affiliated with at least 28 Communist-front organizations, all of which have been declared subversive by an official government agency. Nine of the 28 have been cited as subversive by the attorney general of the United States."

The hearing before the Democratic-controlled committee was billed as a showdown on McCarthy's charges.

McCarthy named the Congress of

American Women as one of the Communist front organizations with which he said Miss Kenyon is affiliated. Then he added:

"As an indication of the far-reaching power and influence of this Communist-front organization, the committee might be concerned to know that Mrs. Dean Acheson, the wife of the secretary of state, is listed on page 1023 of appendix 9 of the records of the house committee on un-American activities as a sponsor of its Washington branch."

"There is no length to which these purveyors of treason will not go to bring into their fold the names of unsuspecting and misguided men and women who are influenced by a glib story of social or economic improvement and thus lend prestige to a sordid and dissolute cause."

Mrs. Acheson appears once on the roster of these subversive organizations and Miss Kenyon more than a score of times.

Tydings touched off a row at the outset by demanding that McCarthy name a high State department official whom McCarthy had accused of shielding disloyal persons.

McCarthy balked, saying he would do so when he gets to that particular case.

Slot Machine Operators Fined As Sequel To Raids

ENTERPRISE, March 10. — (AP) — Two Enterprise pool hall owners were fined in justice court at Walla Walla Wednesday for possession of slot machines.

Justice David Couch fined Grover Stuart \$140 for possession of four machines and Mrs. Vera Eileen Babie \$175 for possession of five machines.

The cases were transferred to Walla Walla because Stuart and Mrs. Babie objected to local hearings.

The day before, at Walla Walla, two similar cases were heard with Frank Hilton and Ada Baker each fined \$105 on charges of possessing three slot machines and punch boards.

One case—that charging possession of slot machines to Chris Eue, Joseph—remains to be heard.

All resulted from last week-end raids by state police. The slot machines had been used openly in this county, and municipalities used license fee revenue for city purposes.
