Radio Set For \$5 Near Reality, Science Believes

NEW YORK (AP)—The five-dollar radio set may be just around the corner.

That is the word from one of the scientists attending the annual convention of the Institute of Radio Engineers.

W. K. Volkers, consulting engineer of Schenectady, N.Y., said the five-dollar set may result from a new circuit design that makes three tubes perform as well as five do in present sets.

In a paper on amplifier circuits, he said the principle of "starvation" in a direct coupled amplifier gave such a drastic increase in over-all gain that the number of amplifier tubes could be cut greatly and overall manufacturing costs reduced accordingly.

Development of a radio tube that can remember what it is told and reproduce the information on request was announced by scientists from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology.

The tube looks somewhat like an automobile muffler made of glass, with an extra pipe coming out one end. It was developed for use in a high speed computing machine under construction at M.I.T. under the auspices of the office of naval research.

The tube can "remember" up to 400 digits. It can receive a number to be remembered in twenty-millionths of a second and, when called upon, fire it back just as fast.
