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Odds Favor Pep To Beat French Fighter Tonight

NEW YORK, March 17 — (AP) — Featherweight champion Willie Pep will be gunning for a quick knockout tonight when he risks his featherweight crown against Ray Famechon, the "unknown" French challenger in a 15-round title bout in Madison Square Garden.

Reports have reached the champion's camp that the Frenchman has been holding out in his public workouts and has been practicing on the sly, away from the prying eyes of newsmen and Pep scouts. Not too much is known about the European featherweight king, who makes his U. S. debut in a blue chip bout.

Willy Willie, however, is in his greatest shape since he injured his back in a plane crash three years ago. "I'll be shooting for a kayo," said Willie. "But if I have to go 15 rounds, I'll be ready to go all out at the distance."

Famechon has not been stopped or floored in 60 pro starts against Europe's best. He has won 57 of 60 contests and has scored 21 knockouts.

Famechon is confident he can spring the upset and capture the world 126-pound crown. "Count on me," he declared. "I didn't come from France just for the journey and the loser's money. I am determined to win."

Robbers Systematic In Gem Store Robbery

CHICAGO, March 17 — (AP) — A pair of calculating robbers held up a south side jewelry store last night.

First the gunmen locked two employees and three customers in a washroom. Then one gunman went outside and his companion forced owner Sol A. Iglow to the inner side of a window showcase.

The "outside man" pointed out each article he wanted Iglow to hand to his confederate. Iglow reluctantly handed out rings, unset jewels, watches and other jewelry and handed them to the gunman who put them in a paper bag. Iglow told police the robbers' selection was valued at more than \$10,000.

Court Removes Child From Life As Film Actress

LOS ANGELES, March 17 — (AP) — Lora Lee Michel, the nine-year-old who ran away from her life as a \$100-a-day actress, is through with the movies—by a judge's order.

Juvenile Judge A. A. Scott said that Lora Lee will be made a ward of the court and "will be kept in juvenile hall and studied for awhile, then she will be placed in another foster home where she can have fun like any other child."

The child twice has complained to authorities that she was beaten and starved in order to keep her weight down for movie roles. Tuesday, however, she reversed her story and told Judge Scott her foster parents had been "wonderful" to her.

"Because Lora Lee is a problem child, without question, we expect to have considerable difficulty in finding a home to suit her needs," the judge said.

"She will be permitted normal visitation privileges from her foster parents and she may, if her viewpoint responds satisfactorily, be permitted at some future time to return to Texas with them in the event they wish to return there."

Her foster parents are Mr. and Mrs. Otto Michel, who adopted the child in 1945 in Texas. Since coming here, Lora Lee has played in a score of movies.

Town's Pet Deer Jailed

METALINE FALLS, Wash., March 17 — (AP) — The town's pet deer is behind bars.

Marshal Stanley Todd locked the tame animal in the town jail after it attacked three-year-old Joe Dee Jones, apparently without cause.

Neighbors and the child's mother rescued the little girl after hearing her screams. She was frightened and bruised but not seriously hurt. The deer's fate is up to the game warden.
