U. S. Not Prepared For A-Bomb Attack, Warning

WASHINGTON, March 29.—(P)—A director of the National Security Resources board, Paul J. Larsen, expressed doubt in testimony released over the weekend that this country should be put in a state of complete readiness for atomic attack.

Larsen told the Senate-House atomic committee that it would cost about \$300,000,000 to decentralize 200 American cities of 50,000 population or more. He added that to gain "absolute security" from A-bomb attack America would have to become a "garrison state."

Larsen conceded that the United States isn't prepared now for an atomic attack. But he said it is better off than it was a year ago and will be still better off in the future.
