A more detailed explanation will be made of the Mobilization Board to show organization and the mission to support logistical and strategic plans developed by the Joint Chiefs of Staff.

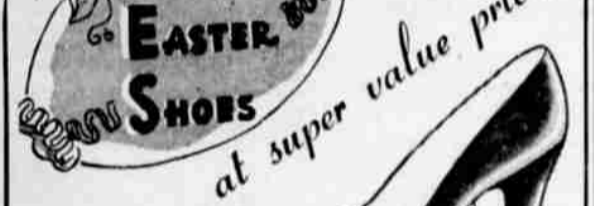
### FIRE DAMAGE SLIGHT
