House Probers Seek Hawaiian 'Fifth Column'

WASHINGTON.—(P)—The House Un-American activities committee hopes to find and expose any "fifth column activities" which may exist in Hawaii.

Rep. Walter (D-Pa) made this statement to reporters as committee members prepared to leave for the territory.

Walter will head the committee's Hawaiian investigation in the absence of Chairman Wood (D-Ga). Wood is not making the trip. Walter said it would be "folly to assume that Russia has overlooked any opportunity to plant agents on militarily important Pacific islands."

One purpose of the Hawaiian investigation, Walter said, is "to prevent, if possible, another Pearl Harbor in the event of war with Russia."

Other committee members who plan to go to Hawaii are Reps. Harrison (D-Va), Moulder (D-Mo), Nixon (R-Calif) and Velde (R-Ill).

They plan to leave Saturday, by plane, and open hearings in Honolulu Monday.

Frank C. Tavenner Jr., committee counsel, said between 75 and 100 witnesses have been lined up. Walter estimated the investigation will require about three weeks.

The investigation is being made at the request of the Hawaiian legislature. The request followed a long dock workers' strike which tied up shipping between the west coast and the islands.

Walter said the committee will seek to find out whether the strike was "inspired by Communist agents."

Expelled Salem Students Appeal To Supreme Court

SALEM.—(P)—Eighteen expelled Salem high school students have appealed to the State supreme court.

The formal transcript was filed with the court, appealing the decision of Circuit Judge Dal M. King, who held the school board acted within its authority in expelling the boys. They had contended the board acted arbitrarily.

The school expulsion was on charges the boys were members of an illegal secret society, known as the American Boys club.

Judge King dissolved a temporary restraining order under which the boys continued in class pending the hearing. He refused to issue a new injunction pending new trial or appeal, opening the way for the board to make it expulsion order effective.
