

Uncle-Niece Marriage Elsewhere O. K. in Oregon

PORTLAND — (AP) — Marriages which aren't legal in Oregon—such as between an uncle and niece—must still be recognized here if performed in other states.

So ruled circuit Judge James W. Crawford, in holding that Mrs. Dora Bernstein had a right to the widow's share of Sam Bernstein's estate.

The two, uncle and niece, were married in Rhode Island after finding that their respective home states of Oregon and New York prevented marriages of such relatives. They made their home here.

The executor of Bernstein's estate had brought suit to deny a claim by Mrs. Bernstein for allowances as the widow. But Judge Crawford ruled that a marriage valid where it occurred should be recognized in this state as valid.

Divorcee Slain As Sequel To Losing Paternity Suit

SAN DIEGO, Calif., April 14—(AP)—The wife of San Diego's "Christmas Tree King," Mrs. Henry A. Pozner, 36, was booked in city jail Thursday on a murder charge after she admitted the fatal shooting of an attractive red-headed woman who only recently lost a paternity suit against Pozner.

Dead was Mrs. Verna Simons, 33, divorcee and former office secretary to Pozner, whose produce business supplies San Diego with a large part of its Christmas trees yearly.

"I only wanted to flatter her," Mrs. Pozner told officers. "I was as surprised as she was when the gun went off."

Superior court records show that Judge L. N. Turrentine last November 2 ruled Pozner was not the father of 5-year-old Martin Duane Simons. Mrs. Simons had filed suit, alleging that Pozner paid the hospital expenses when the child was born and had been his sole support until April 1, 1949. She asked that he be adjudicated the father.

"I warned her and begged her to leave my husband alone," Mrs. Pozner remarked quietly after the shooting, which occurred Wednesday afternoon in front of the victim's residence in uptown San Diego.

Mr. and Mrs. Pozner have two children, a boy, 13, and a girl 7. Mrs. Simons was divorced from Joseph Simons in Reno, Nev. March 6, 1946. They were married in June, 1941.

Turkey Industry Deplores Drop In Price Supports

Portland, April 14 — (AP)—Withdrawal of price supports on chickens and turkeys Thursday was followed here by a one-cent-a-pound price drop on hens.

Poultrymen expressed concern over the end of supports on fowl while supports remain on grain needed for feeding. The price of chickens and turkey feed has increased in the last 10 days.

Oregon poultrymen earned \$31,821,000 on the sale of chickens, turkeys, and eggs during 1949—a drop from the previous year's \$35,632,000.

E. L. Martindale of Columbia Produce company said that while many industry leaders favor withdrawal of support prices, "it does not make sense to support grain at present high levels and remove price supports on the by-products."

He said too the action came too late for northwest turkey producers since a majority either already are brooding poulters or have them on May 1 order.

C. W. Norton, manager of Northwest Poultry and Dairy Products company, saw a possible depressing effect on the breeder turkey market if growers started canceling egg and poult orders. Turkey breeders then, he said, might flood the market.
