

Gambling Probe To Hear Costello, Alleged King-Pin

WASHINGTON, April 27—(AP)—Frank Costello, a reputed king-pin among gamblers, was summoned to trial today under oath today that he knows about big-time wagers in the United States.

Costello was called before a senate commerce subcommittee which is studying a bill designed to cripple the operations of book-makers by banning the movement of gambling information across state lines.

The announcement of the Italian-born Costello's appearance drew wide attention because he has been something of a mystery man despite his denials of any underworld influence. He once described himself as nothing more than a "former bootlegger who couldn't get a traffic ticket fixed."

But last month Senator Wiley (R-Wis.) described him as "an underworld king" and demanded his citizenship be revoked.

Costello and radio men wanted to move in and record Costello's appearance for television and radio audiences. But subcommittee chairman McFarland (D-Ariz.) refused to shift the hearing to a larger room.

The subcommittee has issued subpoenas for two of Costello's acquaintances — Frank Erickson and Joe Adonis.

Theft Repays Kindness To Hungry Stranger

PITTSBURGH, April 27—(AP)—Ira L. Beebe has nothing more than the memories of a delicious dinner for trying to be nice to a stranger.

Beebe's tale started last Sunday when he met a stranger outside of his church. Beebe, who lives alone, was so impressed by the man's tale of misfortune that he gave him \$10 and invited him to spend a few days at his home.

"I'll cook you a good dinner," the man promised.

And the stranger did — Swiss steak, potatoes au gratin and a fine salad.

When Beebe returned from work last night the stranger was missing. And so were two watches, a camera, a radio, a pair of slacks, miscellaneous clothing—and \$67.

Sheriff Denver Young and deputies captured Donald E. Floodstrom, 22, in an auto court. With Floodstrom was a woman the sheriff identified as Winona Burbank, 23, who was charged with hiding an escaped prisoner.

The sheriff said Floodstrom the past three days had moved from one auto court to another.

Still free are Edward Maynard Sharlow and Robert Morrow. Two others were captured by the sheriff the same night they broke out of the jail bull-pen by cutting the wire mesh of a window.
