

Adventists Pass Half-Way Mark In Funds' Goal

Members of the Roseburg Seventh-day Adventist church have passed the half-way mark in their annual solicitation for funds to extend their world-wide uplift program. Calvin V. Hartnell, local pastor reports.

The church plans to reach its \$2,550 goal by May 13. Young people of the church have organized groups to sing hymns in residential sections of the city in the interest of the campaign.

Since this plan of inviting their neighbors to assist in its world-wide mission program was adopted by the denomination 42 years ago, the annual uplift appeal has added \$45 million to the funds given by the members themselves for the support of medical, educational, evangelistic, and other mission

Bruce Ferguson of the Douglas Forest Protective association reported he and his workers are maintaining the lookout roads station and fire roads in south Douglas county at the present time. The work was begun this week and will take about 10 days.

The stations include Bland Mountain lookout and Silver Butte lookout.

Fire camps will be started soon after June 1 and by July 1 they will have a full crew of 20 men at the camp located north of Canyonville and a crew of 10 men at the Quines creek station located two miles south of Azalea.

Ferguson is in charge of all south Douglas county.

Todd Takes Over Service Station

Grant Todd of Medford will take over the Smiley Marine Service station in Reedsport on the water front May 1.

Todd, maintenance man for the Standard Oil Co. for many years is well known to many in this community. He and Mrs. Todd have taken a cabin in Winchester Bay until they can find a home.

The Smiley Marine station is the only one of its kind in Reedsport. It was the first service station and was started in 1921 by Nels Hogan. It was located on the dock near the present county dock. It was housed in the old Fred Varrell building which is now owned by the Umpqua Navigation company. It had its beginning at a time when boats were the principal means of travel on the Umpqua and Smith rivers, before Umpqua Highway 38, Highway 101, and the Smith River road existed. Commercial fishing then made the river a busy place.

When Hogan took over the big Reedsport garage in 1928 he sold the Standard station to Sherman Smiley, who operated it in the same building until 1936 when it was moved to the present Standard Oil building just above the railroad bridge.

Since Smiley's death in December, 1948, his son, Robert, has been in charge of the business.
