Net income for the same period last year was \$5,952,239.  
Sales of lumber, lumber products, logs and pulp for the first quarter of 1950 totaled \$36,670,020, an increase of 7.4 percent over the 1949 figure of \$34,131,449.

He said the clerks of Food Employers, Inc., and the independent grocery employers want \$62.50 for a 40-hour week. About 1,200 union members are involved.
