Pennsy Train Struck

DUNCANNON, Pa., May 8.—(AP)—Skidding cars of a derailed freight train crashed into the Pennsylvania railroad's Broadway Limited near here Saturday. No one was injured seriously.

A PRR spokesman said that five cars of an eastbound freight jumped the tracks at 7:10 a. m. eastern daylight time, and at least one skipped across a track into the Broadway Limited, speeding eastward from Chicago to New York two tracks away.

The Broadway's engineer slammed on his brakes but was unable to stop before the engine, a mail car and three passenger cars were "scraped" by the runaway freight car.

The engineer of the Broadway was taken to Duncannon hospital in this central Pennsylvania territory not far from Harrisburg. He was reported not seriously injured.

Worker-Hiring Methods Now On Improved Basis

(Ed. Note: This is the fourth in a series of articles on the Oregon State Employment service designed to inform the public on the working of the office.)

Because of a wider choice and a better screening of applicants, the employment office has improved greatly on old methods of hiring workers.

"We're just realizing how much time, money and effort we've wasted in selecting personnel," commented one large Oregon employer recently. "The employment office has the information, the equipment and they know how to do the job — why not let them?"

Better employer-employee relationships have resulted in hundreds of cases where trained employment deputies have taken the responsibility for careful selection of workers. With detailed work-history information on thousands of job seekers, the local office can pick the best qualified applicants. In many cases even further tests can be applied — if the job requires some special ability.

In giving an order for help, the employer should be prepared to specify the duties in detail. If unusual physical or mental train-

ing or qualification is necessary, it should be specified. The employment office must know whether the job is temporary or permanent, the proposed rate of pay, hours and working conditions, age limits — if any, requirements of sex or marital status. At times it is helpful to know if the worker must furnish tools or other equipment.

"We can help the employer most when he is honest with us regarding all these working conditions," commented a local manager recently. "If they ask for an expert stenographer when they want an attractive office girl, it will be difficult to serve them properly. We must have co-operation from employer and employee alike."
