Aged Woman To Be Aided In Cost Of Eye Operation

Residents of the Curtin community are sponsoring a public pie social Saturday evening, May 20, to raise money for the "Grandma Allison fund." This fund is for the purpose of providing money to finance an eye operation for Mrs. Allison, who is 88 years old. Since 1944 she has been completely blind from cataracts.

Mrs. Emma Stephens, Mrs. Ada Redifer and Mrs. Grace Thompson head a committee working on the project. Many personal donations have been received and it is hoped enough money may be raised for the operation before her birthday, June 24. Anyone wishing to donate may send contributions to the "Grandma Allison fund," Curtin, Ore., according to Mrs. Thompson, acting treasurer of the group. Her greatest wish, her friends say, is to be able to see her friends and the beauty of nature. Despite her blindness she recently said, happily, "The way to be happy is

to look for the good in others and not look for faults."

Grandma Allison has resided in Curtin with her son-in-law and daughter since 1930. Prior to that she lived in La Grande and Divide, moving from Tennessee in 1926. Rev. Mr. Allison, who was a Methodist minister in Tennessee and a missionary in New Mexico, died in 1904. Of her five children, only two survive.

Bad luck has struck Grandma Allison in the last 10 years, including two fractured hips, pneumonia and an ambulance wreck. Since 1949 she has remained at home and is able to spend some of her days in a wheelchair.
