Former Radio Announcer Held Second Time

HONOLULU (AP)—Erik Van Der Ryjyn, former Kelo, Wash., radio commentator, was arrested Friday for the second time in a week.

He was arrested May 6 at the request of Cowlitz county, Washington, authorities, who said he was wanted on a check forgery charge. A local charge of possession of unregistered firearms also was filed. Freed on \$1,100 bond, Van Der Ryjyn failed to appear for a scheduled hearing last Wednesday. His bondsman offered a \$100 reward for information concerning him.

Meanwhile, Washington authorities asked that he also be picked up on a bigamy complaint. Policeman John M. McCabe spotted him dining in a plantation restaurant on the other side of Oahu island.

Van Der Ryjyn said he had been hiding out in rural districts since last Monday, working odd jobs during the day and sleeping at night in a deserted Army post. "I'm glad it's all over," he said. Police Capt. Eugene F. Kennedy said that Van Der Ryjyn signed a statement that he had forged checks in the name of his former Kelo employer but denied he had committed bigamy.

Captain Kennedy said Van Der Ryjyn told him his real name was Thom J. Flanagan and that he had a wife and four children under that name in Boston, but that he used the name Van Der Ryjyn in the state of Washington. He was booked as Van Der Ryjyn. Captain Kennedy quoted him as saying he would waive extradition to Washington.
