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Japan's Trade Grows But Short Of Prewar Volume

TOKYO—(AP)—Japan doubled her trade last year but still is doing only one-third of prewar business, the international trade and industry committee says.

Exports jumped from 258,000,000 in 1948 to \$510,000,000 in 1949, the report said. Japanese imports also increased, but less sharply.

Japanese purchases totaled \$87,000,000. The "unfavorable" balance tilted Japan's postwar trade deficit to \$1,355,000,000.

The report emphasized the need for trade with southeast Asia and Red China. U. S. aid to southeast Asia might spur Japanese sales, the ministry said.



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Jewish Refugees Heartened By M'Grath's Ruling

NEW YORK, May 31 (AP)—A last-minute ruling by U. S. Attorney-General J. Howard McGrath raised the hopes of 107 Jewish refugees that they may be allowed to stay in the United States.

The group already was aboard a navy transport due to sail for Germany, the homeland of most of them.

The ruling is not permanent, but grants a temporary delay. The refugees were taken to Ellis Island.

They had been evacuated from Shanghai by the International Refugee organization and were brought across the Pacific to the west coast. They crossed the country in a sealed train without visas.

Most had fled to China from Europe during the Nazi persecutions in the late 1930's.

Jewish relief agencies petitioned the attorney general to let them stay long enough to see if they could qualify for residence under present laws or under a new refugee bill pending in Congress.

When they heard the news in the ship's mess, the group started singing "God Bless America." Each one has relatives here.

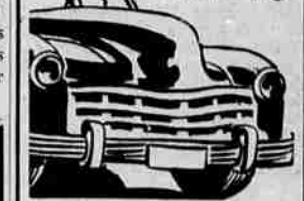
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
