PORTLAND, Ore., July 14.—(AP)—Anglers have a good chance of reporting fine luck if they go fishing this weekend.

The State Game commission's bulletin listed many waters with "excellent" prospects. The report by districts includes:

COASTAL SECTION:—A few searun cutthroat or blueback are entering the central coastal streams but trout angling is still slow. A few salmon are in Winchester bay but most of the fish are being caught outside the bar. Salmon angling on the Rogue is good for this time of year. Striped bass fishing on Coos Bay is slow. A few small bass are being taken on the Millacoma and Coos river. Some large bass have been taken on troll at the highway bridge in the lower bay. Bass, perch, and bluebill fishing is excellent in most of the coastal lakes.

SOUTHERN OREGON:—UPPER UMPQUA—trout fishing is excellent in the upper Umpqua area, including Little river and upper south river. Steelhead migration is strong and catches are just beginning.

DIAMOND LAKE:—some little catches of large rainbow continue to be made.

Murder Conviction Of Clergyman Reversed

ROCHESTER, N. Y., July 14.—(AP)—The appellate division of the New York state supreme court has ordered a new trial for the Rev. George P. Hetenyi, 40, who was convicted last January of second degree murder in the shooting of his 25-year-old wife.

Hetenyi is now serving a sentence of 50 years to life in Attica prison.

The Erie county Episcopal clergyman's conviction by a Monroe county court jury was unanimously reversed yesterday.

The appellate division held that Judge Daniel J. O'Mara erred in charging the jury.

Mrs. Jean Gareis Hetenyi body was found in the river in April, 1949. The minister had reported her missing from their home in the town of Amherst, near Buffalo.
