White-Indian Marriages Held Problem Solution

LOS ANGELES, — (P) — All problems of the American Indian could be solved by intermarriage with whites, says a University of Oklahoma history professor. Dr. E. E. Dale, addressing a summer session audience, said that "once education of the Indian has sufficiently advanced," intermarriage would be practical.

"Indians are a great people and Indian blood is good blood," he said. "Indians have had influence upon our history and culture out of all proportion to their number. In Oklahoma, white-Indian marriages are so common they are not regarded as intermarriage."

North Roseburg Sewer Construction Advances

Clarence V. Landis, chairman of the North Roseburg sanitary district board of directors, announced today that all phases of the sewer work are now under construction. The trunk sewer construction, under contract to Miller and Tallon of Roseburg is more than 50 per cent completed.

Lee Hoffman, contractor for the sewage treatment plant, and Drake Plumbing Co. of Eugene, contractor for the mains and laterals, both started excavation this week, said Landis.

The chairman expects the sewer system to be completed and ready for use by early winter.

Ousted Executive Nicked For That Sum In Divorce

PORTLAND, July 13 — (P) — The ousted president of Doernbecher Manufacturing company, Harry A. Green, will pay a \$320,000 lump-sum alimony to his ex-wife plus a half interest in his \$400,000 Portland mansion.

That was the settlement presented to circuit judge Martin W. Hawkins. He approved it and granted the uncontested divorce decree to Ada Green, 57, from the furniture manufacturer.

On the witness stand, grey-haired Mrs. Green said her husband frequented taverns, "associated with persons he should not have associated with," and made her life unbearable by drunkenness and use of barbiturates.
