'Peace' Petition Branded As Phony Communist Move

WASHINGTON, July 17.—(AP)—The House un-American activities committee wound up Thursday for a blast at an organization which has talked an estimated 1,000,000 Americans into signing a petition for peace.

While the committee was preparing to issue a statement dealing with the "campaign committee for the world peace appeal," two members of the House group said an investigation has disclosed that the organization is dominated by Communists.

Rep. Kearney (R-N.Y.) said the objective is "to confuse and divide the American people and paralyze their resistance to Communist aggression."

Rep. Velde (R-Ill.) said "the traitorous and insidious activities of the American Communist party members are well revealed by this so-called peace offensive."

Kearney and Velde told reporters they estimate 1,000,000 Americans have signed petitions being circulated by the campaign committee. They expressed the opinion that most of the signers were loyal Americans who merely thought they were expressing a desire for peace.

Kearney said the petitions being circulated quote Trygve Lie, secretary general of the United Na-

Angell Doubts Oregon To Get Fifth Congressman

WASHINGTON, July 17.—(AP)—(R-Ore.) says it is doubtful that Oregon will get another congressional district, even though it has had a large increase in population.

He told a reporter it has been generally assumed that the state would merit a fifth congressional district.

But, he continued, because of the increase in population throughout the country, the national ratio of population per congressman has risen from 302,688 in 1940 to 342,500 this year, based on a total population of 150,000,000.

"That's a wonderful sentiment," said Kearney. "But what they are doing is to make it appear that Lie is endorsing this so-called peace appeal."

Kearney said the circulation of the petitions—asking, among other things, the outlawing of the atomic bomb as a weapon of aggression—was "part of the cold war to prepare the path for treason."

Medical Needs After A-Bomb Explosion Enormous

SEATTLE, July 17.—(AP)—A Seattle doctor told a state civil defense conference that 200 carloads of medical supplies would be required for the victims of a single atomic bomb.

Dr. Frank J. Leiby of Seattle, chairman of the civil defense committee of the Washington State Medical association, gave the grim picture. He addressed the university of Washington's institute of government.

Dr. Leiby said such supplies should be stockpiled at a point in each region. It would be inadvisable to stockpile them in every city, he said, because of the cost and the liability of loss in an attack.

The U. S. Fish and Wildlife service says there is some evidence the rosefish migrate considerable distances.

A bomb in such a spot as downtown Seattle, he declared, would wipe out 80 percent of the physicians. Replacements would have to come from other cities, but non-professional first aid teams could be a big aid.

He said 60,000 pints of blood would be needed in any such emergency, and it would have to come from outside.

If an atomic explosion is in the air, the doctor said, danger from radiation would end 90 seconds after the blast.

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
