House Turns Down Plan To Abolish Electoral College

WASHINGTON, July 19.—(AP)—The House Monday killed a proposal to abolish the electoral college and to revamp the machinery by which the nation has named its presidents for 150 years.

The resolution only got 134 favorable votes on a roll call to 210 against—not even a majority. It would have needed a two-thirds vote for adoption.

The House gave it 96 votes less than that.

It turned down a senate-passed resolution that would have submitted to the states a constitutional amendment doing away with the electoral college system and substituting one based on proportionate division of the popular vote. The proposed change, requiring ratification by 36 states, would have divided each state's electoral vote in direct proportion to the popular vote received by the opposing candidate.

House Republican leader Martin of Massachusetts assailed the proposal as a "political Pandora's box."

Instead of simplifying the election system, Martin contended, the change would encourage splinter parties, give the deep south a balance of power in presidential elections, and "could lead to the loss of our two-party system of government."

Negative Vote Keeps Malheur County In Red

VALE, Ore., July 19.—(AP)—Malheur county officials today sought a solution to their financial troubles after voters soundly defeated two special tax measures in Friday's election.

Nearly complete returns showed a vote of 1534 against 868 for a measure to provide \$67,000 above the six per cent limitation for general county services.

The vote was even larger against a \$20,000 county courthouse sinking fund. The count: 1822 no, 549 yes.

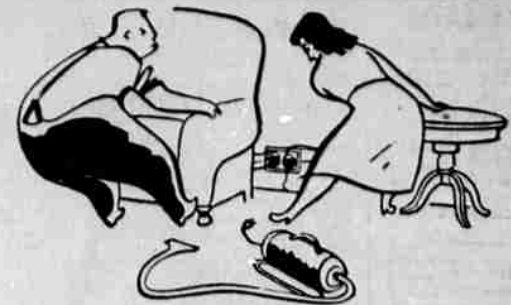
The margin of defeat was bigger than it was in the May primary when the voters first rejected the measures.

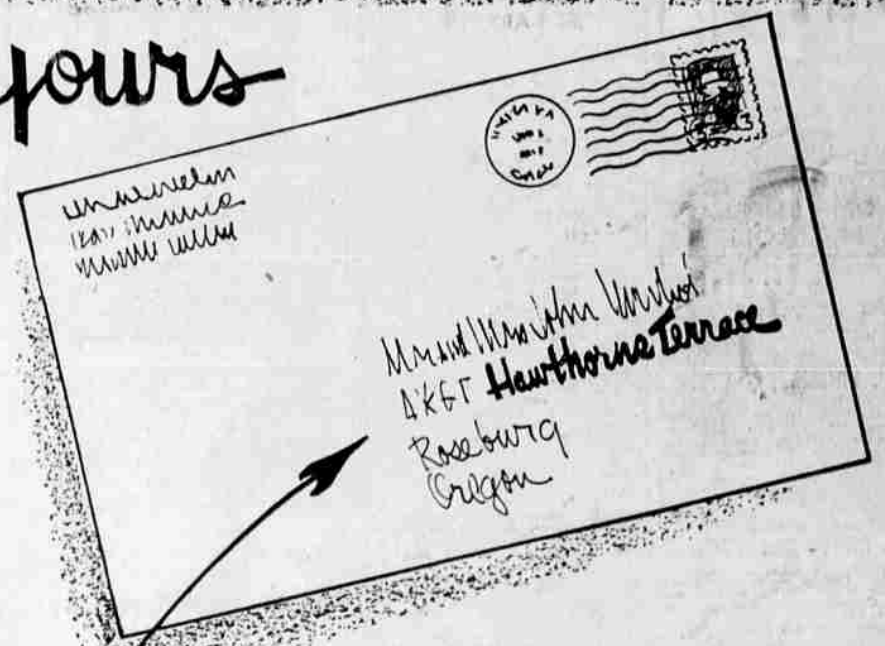
