Georgia Commie Head Manhandled On Street

CARROLLTON, Ga., (AP)—Georgia's Communist party chairman was attacked by three fist-slinging men on the streets of Carrollton Thursday. He came out bloody but not badly hurt.

Walter Bates Chase of Atlanta, the Communist leader, said he went to Carrollton in northwest Georgia in connection with his appeal of a contempt of court citation.

The three men who mauled the Communist leader were not identified. Solicitor general Wright Lippard has asked that Chase's appeal bond be revoked and that Chase be returned to jail on grounds that he is a "menace to society and a danger to the security of the United States."

Chase was cited for contempt in connection with the publication and circulation of pamphlets charging that a Negro, Clarence Henderson, did not receive a fair trial. Henderson was sentenced to death for murder last January, but the state supreme court has ordered a new trial.

New Protestant Group Formed By Whites, Negroes

LAKE FOREST, Ill. (AP)—A Negro and a white church council united yesterday in a new Protestant group, the International Council of Community Churches.

The Rev. Dr. J. B. Howe, pastor of the First Community church of Joplin, Mo., was elected first president. The merging councils were the historical (Negro) Council of Community Churches, headed by the Rev. Joseph M. Evans, of the Metropolitan Community church, Chicago, and the National (white) Council of Community churches, headed by Dr. Roy A. Burkhardt, Columbus, O.

Its constitution defines the new council as a fellowship of religiously minded Christians working to have a united church now and striving for an eventual united world church.

Dr. Burkhardt said the new council will encourage the founding of community churches in thousands of places that can support only one church. The National council, established in 1946, embraces 200 churches with white communicants. The 27-year-old diocesan council was composed of more than 100 Negro churches.
