'Employ Handicapped' Week Objectives Are To Increase Suitable Job Opportunities

Increasing suitable job opportunities for the handicapped will be a major objective of the sixth annual National Employ the Physically Handicapped week which will be observed in Douglas county and throughout Oregon and the nation from Oct. 1 through 7, Chairman Robert Phillips announced today. A community-wide committee sponsoring the "week" met recently, and made plans for an extensive local campaign to find suitable jobs for disabled persons, Phillips said. "In this community, NEPH week will mark the launching of 52 weeks of activity in aiding workers with physical handicaps to solve their employment problems through expansion of placement and rehabilitation opportunities, he said. "At the initial meeting of the committee it was decided that the 1950 NEPH week program should emphasize three main points," said Phillips. "First, we want to make sure that every person in this community is made aware of the job problem of the handicapped and what the community can do to solve it. In the second place we want to be able to provide job openings for all handicapped persons seeking employment. A third objective is to stimulate the use of vocational rehabilitation opportunities by handicapped persons who, at present, are not ready for employment. "Our slogan for the week will be 'Hire the Handicapped—It's Good Business.' We hope to be able to drive home to the entire community the fact that the ability, not the disability, of the handicapped worker is what counts. We want every citizen to realize that handicapped workers are assets not only to themselves but to the entire community when employed in jobs which utilize their abilities. There is no longer any question of this fact because actual work records of employed handicapped workers have proved that they are just as efficient, reliable and versatile as non-handicapped workers when they are placed in suitable jobs. Nude Hitch-Hiker Draws Sentence

SAN MATEO, Calif. — (AP) — Elizabeth Hopkins, 26, Tacoma, Wash., arrested on reports she was hitch-hiking nude, was sentenced by Daly City police Judge William Sweeney to 30 days in jail—for having no visible means of support. Arresting officers refused to believe that it was the California weather which led her to do so, causing major traffic jams on San Mateo county highways. The young woman wasn't talking. She would not tell the name of the man who was seen Tuesday afternoon to jump from a parked automobile on the skyline boulevard south of San Francisco, cloak her in a blanket and whisk away in the car. That was her first appearance. A short while later, however, she appeared at a busy Burlingame intersection during the rush hour, waved at passersby and caused a traffic jam that kept officers from the scene until she had fled. She was taken into custody when found walking through Daly City—still clad only in the blanket—in the pre-dawn chill.
