

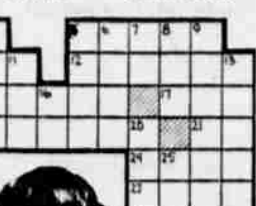

Senator Taylor Loser On Appeal

WASHINGTON — (AP) — The supreme court today denied Senator Glenn Taylor (D-Idaho) a review of his conviction on disorderly conduct charges in Birmingham, Ala. Taylor was fined \$50 and sentenced to 180 days in jail. The charge resulted from a scuffle Taylor had with Birmingham police May 1, 1948, when the senator tried to enter a Negro youth meeting through a door marked "Negro entrance."

Presumably it will now be up to Alabama to begin any proceedings to enforce the sentence. Taylor is now in Idaho.

The incident occurred while Taylor was a candidate for vice president on the Progressive party ticket with Henry Wallace. The senator said his arrest would serve as a test of Birmingham's laws requiring separation of Negroes and whites.

Taylor appealed to the supreme court after Alabama state courts upheld his conviction. Justices Black and Douglas favored a review of Taylor's case. This made the vote 7-2.

THREE 'DRUNKS' JAILED

Municipal Judge Ira B. Riddle reported the disposition of three cases in court Monday.

Joseph Daniel Boule, 32, Jess Bowers, 28, Hammond, and John Lester Parry, 41, Roseburg, all charged with being drunk on a public street, were each committed to the city jail for 10 days in lieu of \$20 fines.

Chester Fink, 35, Sutherlin, entered a plea of not guilty in court Monday to a drunk charge. Judge Riddle set Fink's trial at 2 p. m. Tuesday.
