Blood Test For All As Measure Of Defense Urged

WASHINGTON — (AP)—Efforts to determine the blood type of every person in the nation — on a voluntary basis — were recommended as a civilian defense measure.

A division of the U. S. public health service recommended that the service as a whole, together with state and local health departments, "accept the responsibility for developing efficient, economical community programs" to meet that objective.

"If atomic warfare, or even bombardment by high explosives, resulted in sudden and extensive civilian casualties, the knowledge, on the part of most citizens, of their blood type would result in saving the lives of many people," a civil defense committee of the association of state and territorial health officers said.

"Little time would be available after such a disaster struck to proceed with a mass blood-typing program."

Meanwhile, the acting director of the civil defense office in the national security resources board, James J. Wadsworth, said the nation's civil defense just be organized on a neighbor-help-neighbor basis.

In a broadcast, Wadsworth said that the atom bomb has so multiplied civil defense problems that no one community can expect to stock up all the equipment and manpower it might need in case of an attack.

Mickey Cohen's Smeat Tactics In L.A. Publicized

LOS ANGELES — (AP)— A fantastically effective smear campaign by mobster Mickey Cohen has made the Los Angeles police department "the most maligned" in the nation, Collier's said Friday.

In an article titled "Don't Go Out Alone at Night in L.A.," the weekly magazine said that by remarkable manipulation of the public mind, Cohen and his racketeers have made it appear that the real criminals are not crooks, cutthroats and corruptors—but the police.

"To get the heat off himself, the little hoodlum had built a fire under the police department every time he got into trouble," the Howard Whitman story said. "It was cops and robbers in reverse."

The story had the highest praise for the 4,306-man department and its chief, William H. Parker.

The great harm of Cohen's smoke screen, the article said, is that "cop baiting has diverted public attention from the city's real crime problems . . . crimes against people. The murder, clubbing, robbing and raping of innocent victims; the burglarizing of homes; the strong arming of men and women in the streets; the molestation and defilement of children."
