An economy model Westinghouse. This one was not equipped with any fancy gizmos, such as lights, timers, clocks, altimeters, barometers or such gadgets as ranges have nowadays. This is a plain range, has three units, an oven and storage drawer. That's all. If you go in for ornamental appliances, don't buy it! ELECTRIC RANGE

This westinghouse range is 25 years old and small for its age. We treat it with respect and refer to its legs as "limbs." It has 'em, all four, it's oven is table height. Four units (two work), and a bit scorched around the edges **20.00**

WATER HEATER

A brand new Columbia electric water heater. All was fine until the people who haul things in trucks got at it. When it arrived in Roseburg there were some chips and dents on it that weren't standard equipment. Now we have it and don't want it. 52-gallon capacity. New price \$149.95 — Dented price **95.00**

GAS RANGE

Combination wood and gas job . . . big oven, broiler and four burners plus trash burner. A dandy! All white porcelain finish, neat and sweet. It's Yours for **110.00**

COFFEEMAKER TOPS

Once a long time ago we started out with the same number of coffemaker tops and bottoms. Then you know what. People break more tops than bottoms. So we ordered extra tops, too many extra tops. We've tried to make it all come out even but gave up. Here's the result:

Metal Coffemaker tops, 6 or 8-cup size, narrow and wide neck. Were 1.35 each **69c**

FLOURESCENT LIGHTING FIXTURES

Here are bargains in fixtures. Buy for shop, garage, warehouse, etc. These were used by a local furniture company, and are in excellent re-usable condition. Each is eight-foot, 4-tube fixture built for slimline units. **39.95**
New price is \$72 each. (4 only) (less lamps)

4' FLOURESCENT FIXTURES

Suspension type 4-lamp fluorescent fixtures with frosted glass sides and louvered bottom. Very swank and modern, Brand new. All metal is aluminum color. We are overstocked, so are reducing these to clear. Save nearly \$20 on each. They were 49.50. Now just (less **29.95** lamps) — Each

RANGETTE OVEN

This is gadget that tried to be an oven. It's a plain, insulated tin box with a door in front. That's about all. Designed for simple baking, it's o.k. to slide on a hot plate for warming rolls, bread, etc., when your oven is in use. Might bake pies and cakes but we never heard of anybody that tried it. Were 12.50 **6.25**

ROASTER OVENS

We often wonder why these are so unpopular. The idea is sound, it works, the gadget is useful and foolproof. But nobody wants one. A roaster oven (we have two sizes) is a nice, portable oven. Just plug in to any wall socket and get cookin'. Complete with rack, containers for meats, vegetables, potatoes, etc. You can cook a complete meal easily and quickly with one. Graniteware fitted containers, white porcelain exterior. The 18 quart model was 49.95 and very reasonable, now we'll take 34.95. The 6 quart job isn't quite so elaborate and not so large, fine for one or 2 people with small appetites. Was 21.95. Now **16.95**

BUFFET SERVICE

Buffet service is a fancy name for a glorified hot plate — coffemaker combination. This is a chrome service with two hot plate units plus two coffemaker units with upper The idea is to have coffee makin' in one and warmin' in the other. Also use the service for warming soups and other edibles. All chrome and very fancy. **12.95**
Was 29.95

SUN LAMP

Here is probably the ultimate in sun lamps. Very fancy and complicated looking but actually kind of simple. The sun lamp is the mercury vapor type with "a burn-out proof genuine pure quartz tube" — so it says on the label. And there's "a built-in automatic timer" and "activated radio tube." An ultra-violet lamp that gives you sun tans in December, is supposed to have powers to cure colds, relieve sinus . . . might even be good for falling hair, ingrown toenails and other assorted ills. Just plug into any wall socket and absorb the ultra-violet rays. Complete with leatherette carry case. Was 64.50. Look at this! **19.95**

SWITCH BOXES

We're not sure why we have so many of these. Heavy metal switch boxes with loom clamps and horizontal side brackets. Were 40c each **19c**

Wringer model. Very streamlined, white porcelain. Quiet and smooth — Will even wash clothes **49.95**

Vaccine Against Gas Gangrene In Testing Process

ST. LOUIS — (AP) — Hope is offered for the development of a protective vaccine against gas gangrene, an always-feared complication of war wounds.

Gas gangrene is a wound infection caused by germs that live in soil. Armies fear it because of the possibility of the wounded being contaminated where they fall.

A Canadian doctor told the American Public Health association that statistics for World War II "show that no marked progress has been achieved since 1918 in the specific treatment of gas gangrene in war wounds" despite the use of such drugs as the sulfas and penicillin.

And, said Dr. Victorien Fredette of the University of Montreal, "still less has been accomplished in the way of preventive immunization."

But he declared "new hope" for a vaccine is offered by a substance recently found in cultures of "clostridium perfringens" — the principal germ involved in gas gangrene.

He calls it the "bursting factor" because he believes it to be the activating agent that causes toxin, or poison, from the germ to produce infection.

And yet, said the doctor, this separate factor in itself does not have the poisonous properties of toxin. Also, it appears to set up immunity to the germ's action when it is injected into experimental animals.

Guinea Pigs Survive Tests
In tests with guinea pigs, he related, vaccinated animals all survived "challenge" doses of gas gangrene germs.

In contrast, 80 percent of one group of unvaccinated animals were killed, and 58 percent of another group.

In another report, Dr. A. R. Woodburne, Denver, Colo., skin specialist, told of a new wait treatment.

It involves use of liquid nitrogen, which "boils" when it is placed on the wart — producing a temperature of 180 degrees below zero as it changes from a liquid to a gas.

Thus, said Dr. Woodburne, the wart is frozen, and falls off in from one to two weeks.

The doctor said the nitrogen treatment "doesn't leave a scar or a raw open area, as is usually the case with such treatments as X-ray, dry ice, acetic acid and other acids."

FAIRBANKS, Alaska — (AP) — A 17-year-old high school youth, David Osborne, became Fairbanks' third polio victim Monday. The boy was stricken last Friday and was put into a respirator Sunday.

Earlier polio victims included a child at the Ladd air force base and an Eskimo from Point Barrow.

Meanwhile, hospital attendants said Julian Rivers, son of Alaska's former attorney general, appeared to be recovering.

Twelve-year-old Jo Anne Wald, confined to a respirator for several weeks, will be flown to Seattle Friday for rehabilitation treatment.
