Mexico To Offer Jobs To Halt Exodus To U.S.

MEXICO CITY.—(AP)—Mexico's government will establish a federal employment service to try to find jobs at home for Mexicans who want to go to the U. S. to work. Many Mexicans have flooded into the U. S., some legally but most illegally, in search of work. The Interior ministry said it will tell workers in the future where there is need for farm and other labor and what salaries they can expect in their own country.

City Manager Gets Pay Cut At Her Own Request

JACKSONVILLE BEACH, Fla.—(AP)—Mrs. Clare Swanson, city manager, got a \$1,000 cut in her salary last night—but she asked for it. In a letter to the council, she suggested her \$6,000 annual pay be trimmed and the difference added to the salary of a new director of public works. The board liked the idea. Former City Manager Hugh McCotter will get the new post at the same salary as the city manager, \$5,000.
