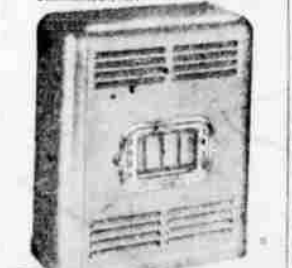

House Group Will Hear Complaints On Credit Control

WASHINGTON — (AP) — A senate-house committee has decided to start public hearings Dec. 6 on complaints from dealers and the general public against the present credit controls on automobile sales.

The hearings will be conducted by the joint "watchdog" committee set up to study operation of the economic controls law which Congress enacted last September.

At an organization meeting, the group named Senator Maybank (D-S.C.) chairman and Rep. Paul Brown (D-Ohio) vice chairman.

Maybank said the hearings on auto controls will be followed by a series of sessions starting Dec. 12 on real estate credit restrictions. Another series of hearings the next week will deal with allocation of scarce materials, miscellaneous controls, and what Maybank termed "serious hoarding" in the case of some industrial items.

The economic controls law gave the Federal Reserve board full jurisdiction over installment buying terms. Under its regulation, the board first issued an order requiring one third down on new and used cars with no more than 21 months to clear up the balance. A few weeks later that was changed to a maximum of 15 months to pay.

Maybank said the Reserve board order has been particularly hard on used car dealers and the "poorer people" who need cars to get to work.

He plans to propose to the board that it issue "certificates of necessity" which would entitle low and moderate income purchasers of lower priced cars to more liberal credit terms.
