

# Armament Aid To Replace Terminating Marshall Plan In Bracing British Economy

NEW YORK — (AP) — American dollars will continue to flow to Britain. The name of the aid will be changed but before it's over the

volume may be even greater. Marshall plan aid — designed to rebuild England's industries and trade — will end officially in a couple of weeks, although the funds already granted under it will continue to trickle overseas for some months to come. Altogether, more than \$2.6 billion of Marshall dollars went to Britain, after earlier loans and grants of around \$4 billion had failed to do the trick.

**Stepped Up Program**  
Armament aid designed to rebuild England's military production capacity — is due to be stepped up rapidly from now on. Two problems must be licked first, and both are being tackled now. First, is the "sharing out" of the rearmament burden among the members of the North Atlantic pact — with all bets being laid on Uncle Sam's picking up most of the check. Details are being worked out now.

Second is the drafting of international controls over strategic materials. Decision to do this was made at the recent talks between President Truman and Prime Minister Attlee. Practical details of putting it into operation are ticklish this time. In the last war the United States and Britain made the decisions and portioned out the raw materials largely as they saw fit. This time a number of other nations are involved — nations who have raw material sources and nations who need to rebuild their arms production. When the American-British plan was drawn up in the last war, many of these other nations had already been knocked out, and working out the details of strategic material control between the two remaining big powers was comparatively simple.

The end of the Marshall aid needn't choke the British economy. British industries and the whole British business world will continue to profit, however indirectly, as the rearmament dollars replace the Marshall dollars.

**Civilian Goods Cut**  
In some ways the changes in benefits will be comparable to what will be taking place here. There will be little or no direct benefit to industries making goods for British civilian consumption. There will be expansion and increased production rates for industries making war essentials. And the dollars spent on this production will trickle down through the entire British economy.

Americans who export goods to the British will be affected by the dollar switch — over in type of dollar aid. They have the word of day of the British chancellor of the exchequer that England doesn't plan further restriction on its imports from America. But U. S. manufacturers realize that as Britons tighten their belts financially to rebuild their defenses, they'll be buying fewer purely consumer — type goods from this side.

## Anti-Rosenberg Charges Baseless, Morse Says

WASHINGTON — (AP) — Senator Morse (R-Ore) said today charges of communist sympathy against Assistant Secretary of Defense Anna M. Rosenberg "had collapsed completely for lack of proof." Morse is a member of the armed services committee, which has been holding closed hearings on Mrs. Rosenberg's nomination for more than a week. It had unanimously recommended on Nov. 14 that she be confirmed, but senate action has been held up for investigation of new allegations. Mrs. Rosenberg has repeatedly denied any sympathy for Communism or its front.
