**Spring Pig Crop To Be Peacetime Record, Forecast**

WASHINGTON — (AP) A record peacetime spring pig crop of 62,700,000 head is forecast by the Agriculture department. This crop will provide the nation's pork supply next fall and winter. While six percent larger than this year's spring crop of 59,997,000 head, the indicated production may not be big enough to satisfy increasing civilian and military demands for meat under price control and rationing by next summer. Pork makes up nearly half the meat supply. Little increase is forecast for next year's supplies of beef, veal, lamb and mutton. The predicted spring crop of pigs compares with a 10-year (1933-42) average of 53,191,000 head and with the record of 74,223,000 in the wartime year of 1943. Production of pigs for the 1949 and 1950 fall crops, respectively, by major producing states included Washington 115,000 and 84,000; Ore 101,000; and 198,000. **Chinese Army Of 12 Million During 1951 Foreseen**

HONG KONG — (AP) — Communist China, with her vast reservoir of manpower, may have a fighting force of 12,000,000 men by the end of 1951. That seems a fair estimate unless something unexpected happens to the plans for Red China's war machine. New additions to the Communists' huge army are reported daily. But it is becoming increasingly difficult to keep track of mobilization statistics. Available figures and current news dispatches give this size-up of Red China's forces, actual and potential: She now has a regular army of 5,000,000 men. "Irregular" forces are understood to number another 5,000,000. Many of these "irregulars" are being shaped into fighting form. The Chinese Communists' total mobilization campaign — if it continues at its indicated pace — is expected to add another 2,000,000 in the coming year. The Red announced their mobilization campaign Dec. 12. Peiping called for all workers and students to enter military training schools. They should prepare themselves, the Peiping government declared, for keeping "the dirty swines' lips from sticking into the fence of our beautiful garden." Such expressions are common in the Chinese Reds' "hate America" campaign.
