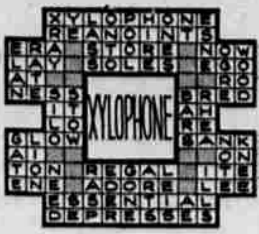


Crossword puzzle grid with clues for words like 'Depicted beef cattle', 'Church part', 'Fruits', etc.

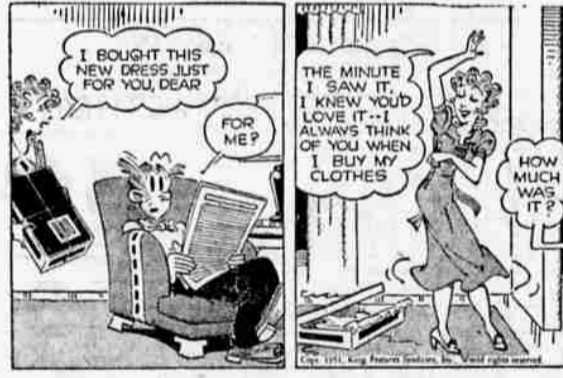

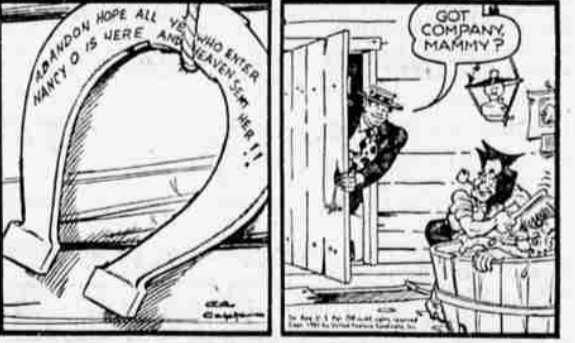

Merger Advice Given Outlying School Districts

Prospective population growth in Green, Tenmile, Lookingglass, Roberts Creek, Olalla, Dillard and Camas Valley communities makes it advisable for those districts to set up their own high school system.

This is the opinion of directors of the Roseburg district school board.

Notification of the recommendation by the Roseburg board has been given boards in each of the affected districts.

Dr. Huffaker states in his report that a satisfactory high school can be operated with a minimum of 200 pupils.

Alternative Plans Advised If Roseburg is to continue accepting tuition students from non-high school districts, construction of additional facilities will be necessary.

Consolidation of northern districts - Wilbur, Deer Creek, Garden Valley, Umpqua, Melrose, Winchester and Riversdale - with Roseburg was recommended by Dr. Huffaker.

Deer Creek district, however, voted recently to consolidate with Glide district.
