Merger Advice **Given Outlying School Districts**

Prospective population growth in Green, Tenmile, Lookingglass, Roberts Creek, Olalla, Dillard and Camas Valley communities makes it advisable for those districts to set up their own high school sys-

This is the opinion of directors of the Roseburg district school board.

board.

Notification of the recommendation by the Roseburg board has been given boards in each of the affected districts. The statement that the districts comprising the "southern group," as they are termed in the Huffaker report, "would be better off in the long run to consolidate with each other" is not meant, however, to close the door to consolidation with the Roseburg district, Roseburg school officials say.

The consolidation issue was

officials say.

The consolidation issue was raised in the recent report by Dr. Carl Huffaker, University of Oregon, advisor to the state board of education, who was asked by the Roseburg school board to study the local school problem and to recommend a future course of action. Basing its action upon his findings, the board has announced it will not accept tuition pupils after July 1, 1932. At present the Roseburg school system is educating 485 tuition high school students, of which number approximately 250 come from the southern district.

Dr. Huffaker states in his report that a satisfactory high school can

that a satisfactory high school can be operated with a minimum of 200 pupils. He estimates that the southern district within five to eight years will have a high school census of approximately 800 pu-nils

Alternative Plans Advised

Alternative Plans Advised

If Roseburg is to continue accepting tuition students from nonhigh school districts, construction of additional facilities will be necessary, the report states. Financially, the program could be operated equally well for all the districts involved, including Roseburg, either by consolidating into one large district, or by setting up a separate district for the southern area. But, due to anticipated future growth, the separate district plan has been suggested.

Consolidation of northern districts — Wilbur, Deer Creek, Garden Valley, Umpqua, Melrose, Winchester and Riversdale — with Roseburg was recommended by Dr. Huffaker, who stated that this area shows indications of slower growth than the southern district, and its geographical situation is better suited to consolidation with Roseburg.
