

Cargo Of Molasses, Health **Books Hit By Government**

WASHINGTON — (AP) — The government contends that Gayelord Hauser's book, "Look Younger, Live Longer," never should have been stuck in with a shipment of blackstrap molasses.

Copies of the book, and the molasses shipment have been seized by Food and Drug administration agents and a complaint filed in federal court in Buffalo, N. Y.

In announcing this action Friday, the agency charged that the book falsely suggests the molasses would increase life five years and abate troubles ranging from heart disease te baldness.

The announcement said the book, which has been widely reviewed and condensed in magazines, served as a label for the molasses.
Another book, "Crude Black Mo-Another book, "Crude Black Mo-lasses," by Cyril Scott, also was seized with the shipment, the

Ralph Kneeland, assistant to the food and drug commissioner, said the molasses was shipped from the Natures Food Center, Boston, to the center's branch office at Rochester, N. Y.

Heary Rosenberger, president of Natures Food Center, said he had "no comment" but that the matter had been referred to attorneys for Farrar & Stauss Co., New Yos, publishers of the health books, and the Allied Molasses Co., Inc., of Perth Amboy, N. J.

Reached at his home in Plainfield, N. J., Harold M. Ross, vice president of the Allied Molasses Co. said be had not beard of the seizure.

Denies Charge

"We only sell molasses," he commented. "We do not ship any of our products in conjunction with Gayelord Hauser's book or any other publication."

Kneeland said labels on the

kneeland said labels on the pint and quart jars of blackstrap failed to give information required on food for apecial dietary uses regarding vitamin, mineral and other properties. He said the labels read, "Plantation (The oiginal blackstrap Molsses parked by the Al. "Plantation (The original blackstrap Molasses packed by the Allied Molasses Co., Inc., Perth Amboy, N. J."

Across the face of the label, Kneeland added, was the statement, "Recommended and endorsed by Gayelord Hauser."

The government's complaint said the blackstrap was mishranded by

the blackstrap was misbranded be-cause of statement's in Hauser's book suggesting it would, among other things:

Add five years of youthful life;
serve as an excellent source of
vitamins; be effective against
menopause and menstrual difficul-

menopause and menstrual difficulties, constipation, poor digestion,
and gas; induce sleep, correct neryousness, help grow hair and treat
changes due to old age.

The Scott booklet suggested the
product also was useful in prevention and treatment of cancer,
arthritis, ulcers, dermatilis, eczema and several other ailments,
the agency charged. It contended
the product will not do any of the

The monthly snow survey compiled by the irrisation division of the SCS showed that the snow pack on the upper Columbia, Kootenai, Okanogan and Methow rivers are from 133 to 163 percent of normal.

"If the present trend in snow cover accumulation continues, cou-pled with low temperatures until late spring, high water can cause damage in vulnerable areas again," the agency warned.

The snow pack in the remainder of the Columbia river basin is about normal although the Malbeur drainage in easter Oregon is threatened with possible madequate irrigation water this year.

Reservoir storage is well-below the ten year average in the area and the water content of the snow

Otherwise the irrigation outlook for this year is "generally good," the agency reported.

Snow pack on the Kootenai river, the furbulent stream which over-flows in the Bonners Ferry region of northern Idaho nearly every year, is 33 percent above normal. The upper Columbia river watershed in Canada has a snow pack 163 percent of normal.
