The latest White Paper reiterates that Rus-sia has been supplying 'direct mil-itary pressure'' against Yugoslavia and has been supplying the Soviet satellites with arms and troops for the overthrow of Tito's govern-ment.

Stalin's second wife was Na-dezhda (Nadya) Alliluyeva, whom he married sometime during the Civil war which followed the revo-lution, possibly in 1919. She is be-lieved to have committed suicide in 1932 after a spat with Stalin in the presence of high members of his Polithuro. Her death so jolted Stalin that he was on the point of resigning from the Com-munist party leadership, but V. M Molotov is said to have persuaded him to stay on. Stalin's first wife was Ekaterina Svandedze, who died during the revolution. They had one son, Jacob Allifuyeva was the mother of two of Stalin's children: Vassily, now a lieutenant-general, and Svel-lane, his daughter and constant companion. Madezhda was the daughter of

Nadezhda was the daughter of an old revolutionary named Alli-luyev who once was a close friend of Lenin, and it was a close friend of Lenin, and it was through his as-sociation with Lenin that Stalin met his second wife. Another daughter of the old Bolshevik, S. A. Alliluyeva, published a book about Stalin in 1945, under the tille "Reminiscence." A year later "Reminiscences." 
