Malheur Defies Oregon Daylight Saving Order

ONTARIO, Ore. — (AP) — Malheur county has defied Oregon law, its residents announcing they would refuse to change to daylight saving time with the rest of the state Sunday.

The chamber of commerce secretary, H. F. Logue, warned Governor McKay of Oregon that it would perhaps be the biggest mass law violation in the history of the state.

"I'm not going to send the national guard over there to enforce the time law," he said the governor replied. Oregon passed a law last year to require the entire state to go on daylight time when the governor proclaims it. He has set April 29 for the change-over.

The Malheur refusal is based on the fact that a change to daylight time would make the county a small island of time, its clocks at variance with all others in the Pacific Northwest.

The county is the only one in Oregon on mountain standard time. When it is 6 p.m. Pacific standard time in Portland, it is 7 p.m., mountain standard time here and in Boise. A change to daylight time would make it 7 p.m. in Portland, 8 p.m. in Ontario, and 7 p.m. in Boise, which will remain on mountain standard time.

So Malheur county intends to remain on mountain standard time—so that when it is 7 p.m. (PDT) in Portland, it will be 7 p.m. (MST) here and in Boise.

No Reduction in Disarmament, Britain's Pledge

LONDON — (AP) — Foreign Secretary Herbert Morrison pledges that Britain would cut its standard of living before slashing its proposed rearmament program.

Morrison's statement, made in a speech here, came as the high command of the British Labor government crushed a leftwing rebellion over the rearmament program and the party pledged firm support to Prime Minister Attlee's policies.

The statement by Morrison, at a luncheon of the American Chamber of Commerce, was looked upon as Attlee's answer to the rebels, who had complained that the United States was dragging Britain into a ruinous expenditure for arms.

Departing from his prepared speech, Morrison told his audience that the problem of raw materials for British home production, export and rearmament is causing "most serious anxiety."

Morrison, who recently succeeded the late Ernest Bevin in the foreign ministry, pleaded with the U. S. to help Britain get raw materials. He said that if a shortage of these materials slowed down Britain's production, it would be a chieftain's policy to let the armament program take the first cut or is full effect.

Britain, he said, would try to

"take the burden on its current standard of life."
"That would not mean an easier budget, but a harder one."
This touched a sore spot in the current British debate. It was the objections of Aneurin Bevan, who has just resigned as labor minister, to the size, speed and method of financing British rearmament which touched off the rebellion. Harold Wilson supported Bevan by resigning as president of the board of trade.

Four Young Joy-Riders Facing Charge Of Murder

SEATTLE — (AP) — Four young joy-riders from Montana and Utah, one of them a 15-year-old girl, pleaded innocent here to first degree murder charges.

All were held in jail. They are Daniel Edmond Garrity, 20, Butte; Billy G. Callihan, 23, from the Great Falls air force base; Donna Christian, 20, and Geraldine Allred, 15, both of Ogden, Utah.

They were arrested in San Francisco in connection with the killing here of Robert Whitlock, 39, after his abandoned car was found there. Whitlock's body was found hidden in brush off the Seattle-Tacoma highway. Authorities said he had been robbed.
