

Education Bills Killed in House

SALEM — (AP) — The House defeated two Senate bills relating to education. One would require that all school teachers get at least 10 days of sick leave a year, and the other would allow the large school districts to operate junior colleges.

A bill to let the circuit courts declare people sane after their discharge from mental hospitals was passed by the House and so to the Senate. There now is no way for a person to be declared legally sane after his mental ailment is cured.

A bill to let the State Board of Higher Education refund about \$7,000,000 worth of dormitory bonds was passed by the Senate and sent to the governor. It will save about \$1,200,000 in interest.

The House isn't sold on television. It deferred 20 to 24 a senate memorial asking the Federal communications commission to authorize a television station in Portland.

PRINCIPAL RESIGNS

Prof. J. H. Bush, who was recently elected principal of Drain grade school, has tendered his resignation to the school board, the Drain Enterprise reports.

No reason for his resignation was given. Mr. Bush, who is completing his fourth year as principal of the Drain school, was formerly at Falls City. He is a graduate of Oregon State college and Oregon College of Education. His successor has not been named.
