Roseburg and Douglas county will participate in a national survey of public school facilities being conducted by the Federal Department of Education upon request of Congress for the purpose of obtaining average school building cost information.

National Forests Movie Exhibited At Rotary Meet

"Every Man's Empire," a color film showing the extent, purpose and importance of the U. S. national forests, was received with hearty applause by Roseburg Rotarians at their Thursday noon luncheon in the Hotel Unmpqua.

Program Chairman Ray Hampton, fire assistant, Umpqua National forest, prefaced the movie with a quotation from Ben Hur Lampman's "Wardens of Greenland." Lampman's essential philosophy was that each of us is a warden who is sworn to keep the forest from the flame while the trees, in turn, are the wardens of the people's happiness because of material contributions.

The movie stressed the point that each of us has a share in the 152 national parks in the nation. Boiled down, the share amounts to about a football field each.

"Forest lands were first put aside for national preservation in 1891. The U. S. Forest service, under the Department of Agriculture, was established to care for the lands.

"Striking views of forests, mountains, and streams flicked across the screen as the narrator listed the values inherent in our national park system: They protect the headwaters of our water supply; provide the last refuge for wild animals; and recreation facilities, timber, range, campgrounds, and resort grounds.

"A letter from R. Cloyd Riffe, vocal music supervisor of city schools, thanked Rotary for its project in which five local students were provided with season Community Concert tickets.

"A letter signed by Elizabeth Randall, director of guidance at Roseburg Senior high, thanked Dr. John Haskins, who was in charge of the club's vocational guidance program, for his effective work in that field.

School administrators of southwestern Oregon met in an all-day session in Roseburg Wednesday with federal and state officials who explained the mechanics of the survey. Douglas County Superintendent Kenneth F. Barneburg and Roseburg Superintendent Paul Elliott represented this area.

Federal representative was Dr. James Woolfer, U. S. Office of Education, school facilities survey representative for 31 western states, and state officials present were James Turnbull, Oregon school building consultant, and Harvey Wright, who is in charge of transportation with the Oregon Department of Education.

Twenty-six delegates representing Douglas, Lane, Jackson, Curry, Coos and Josephine counties heard the discussion leaders describe the federal survey which will determine the needs for school buildings for the next 10 years; the need for federal aid for school buildings; and provide Congress with the information necessary to appraise state requests for federal school building funds.

In addition, survey information will provide valuable data for the state system, which has never attempted a survey.

The officials explained how the survey should be administered and the type of questions to be answered, which include: type of classrooms, number of classrooms, number of pupils, number of buildings, adequacy of the buildings, etc.

Forms for the local survey should be available soon. Deadline for completion of the survey has been set at July 1.

County superintendents C. R. Bowman, Lawrence Moffitt, and Mrs. Martha Purdy, representing Jackson, Josephine and Coos counties, respectively, attended the conference.

Public Housing Units For Riddle Given Approval

Eight units of public housing for Riddle have been approved by President Truman, according to a telephone call received from the Federal Housing authority from Seattle by H. L. Scofield, executive director of the Housing authority of Douglas county. A site has already been obtained, and construction is expected to start this summer.

Approval is also expected within the next few weeks for a similar number of housing units for Oakland.

Planning on the 60-unit housing project for Roseburg is nearing the final blue print stage, where it will be possible to call for bids for construction at an early date, said Scofield.

Intermediate drawings have been approved, calling for 30 duplexes and an office and maintenance building. The project is to be located west of the new Fullerton school on property purchased from the Brown estate.

The low-cost rental housing will consist of one, two, three and four-bedroom homes. The four-bedroom units will be two-story. The others will be one-story.

An entrance road 60 feet wide has been dedicated from the Melrose road and will extend 735 feet south to the property site. The road will have an oil-macadam surface, and a sidewalk will be built along the east side.

Plans call for installation of sewers, water mains and electricity. The open ditch across the property will be replaced with a covered, 30-inch drain tile. Lawn and shrubbery contracts will be included in the construction.

The Douglas county court has appointed Paul Abel as commissioner of the local housing authority for a five-year term, beginning April 14. Abel, a retired merchant here, is devoting a great deal of his time to civic activities.

Fire At Three Mile Causes \$50,000 Loss

A fire at the Doernbecher Manufacturing Co. logging operation on Three Mile creek, near Gardiner, destroyed a large yarder and logging lines April 21, the Port Umpqua Courier reported.

The fire burned over 20 acres of slash and caused approximately \$50,000 loss. Origin of the fire is unknown.

A crew from Crown Zellerbach helped the Doernbecher crew bring the fire under control. The company said they would retain their crew, but estimated it would be two weeks before they could start production.
