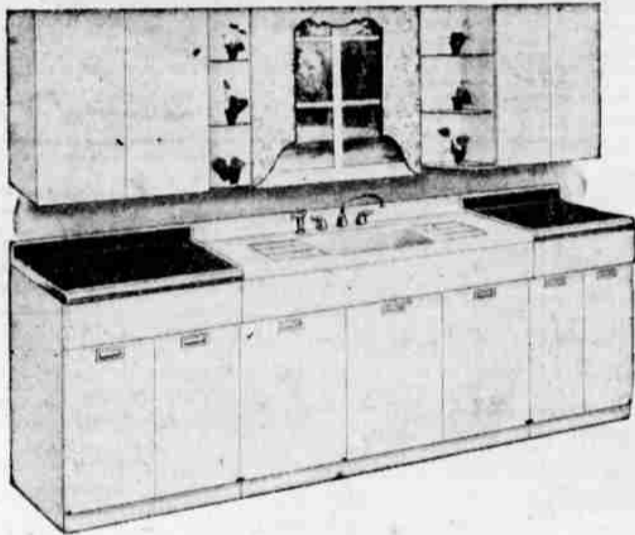

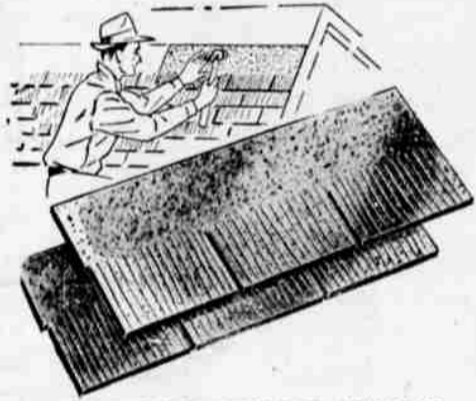

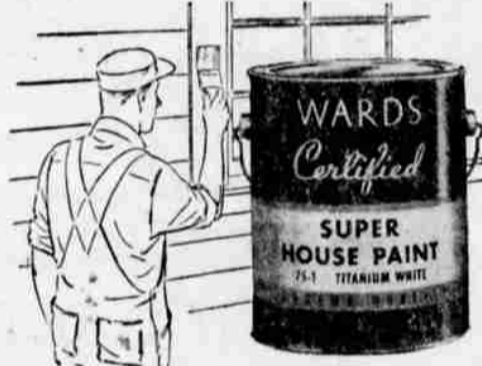

Former Canyonville Boy Drowns Near Medford

Donald Beach of Medford, who attended the local high school as a junior earlier this term, Donald, his mother, Mrs. Lucille Beach, and his sister, Virginia, lived at the Evergreen Motel here.

Donald was drowned in Rogue river while swimming near the mouth of Butte creek. His sister, Virginia, and two other companions, also of Medford, saw him disappear over a shelf of rock.

They summoned an ambulance and a resuscitator. State police and the sheriff's squad were called to the river later and a tank of oxygen was used in an attempt to revive him when his body was removed from the stream. Interment was in Los Angeles.
