Gen. Eisenhower To Be Available, GOP Chief Says

WASHINGTON — GOP — Harry Darby, Kansas Republican national committeeman, predicts Gen. Dwight D. Eisenhower will be available for the 1952 GOP presidential nomination.

Darby, former senator who supported Gov. Thomas E. Dewey of New York when it latter won the 1948 nomination, is looked upon by some as the unofficial manager of an unofficial campaign to get next year's nomination for Eisenhower.

Eisenhower declined to seek either the Republican or Democratic nomination three years ago and has said he was "not going to let any sort of talk by others make me a candidate."

Remarkable he is confident the five-star general will become available. Darby said in an interview he hasn't talked to Eisenhower about the matter and doesn't believe anyone should while the latter is in uniform as head of the North Atlantic defense forces.

"I believe the American people want him for President and when the time comes, I believe Eisenhower will answer the call, just as he has always answered all calls to duty," Darby said.

The Kansas committeeman expects to head a home state delegation pledged to Eisenhower as a "favorite son" candidate. He is reported to have been given a go-ahead signal from Dewey and Senator Duff (R-Pa.), Eisenhower supporters, to do what he can to organize backing for the general. Darby and others apparently think Eisenhower could run away with any primary in which his name was entered. But they don't want any formal campaign launched for the general while he is in uniform and they frankly don't know how long he will have to stay on the job in Europe.
