Fare Increase Permit Given Two Bus Lines

SALEM — (AP) — Pacific Greyhound lines and Continental Pacific Trailways were given permission to increase their bus fares for trips within Oregon of less than 150 miles.

Public Utilities Commissioner George H. Flagg said he allowed the fare increase because the companies are losing money on their bus business within Oregon.

The basic fare for trips of 50 miles or less will be boosted from 2 cents a mile to 2½ cents. The increase for trips of 51 to 100 miles will be increased from 1.9 cents per mile to 2.3 cents.

For trips of 101 to 150 miles, the increase will be from 1.8 cents a mile to 2 cents. Fares for trips of more than 150 miles are unchanged.

Commutation fares for 10 rides will be eight times the one-way fare. This fare now is seven times the one-way tariff.
