

**Reactionaries Spell GOP Defeat, Morse Says**

PORTLAND — (AP) — Sen. Wayne Morse (R-Ore.) doesn't think Republicans can win the 1952 elections if they follow the "reactionary" wing of their party.

That is what he said in a letter declining an invitation to attend a Multnomah county Republican club picnic at which Sen. Joseph McCarty (R-Wis.) is scheduled to speak.

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**Oil Products' Rationing Unlikely, Agency Says**

WASHINGTON — (AP) — There is little likelihood that oil products will have to be rationed this winter, Al Frame of the petroleum administration for defense says.

Frame told an industry group "there will be tightness in fuel oil but for all other petroleum products I can't see where there will be any rationing."

Secretary of the Interior Chapman has cautioned that some rationing of oil products may be necessary in eight to ten months if the industry does not get the steel it needs for pipelines and well drilling.

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**Former Convict-Artist Draws Another Term**

NEW YORK — (AP) — When Harold A. Sells, 47, was serving a 40-year prison term for armed robbery, he used his proficiency in masonry and woodcarving to help construct the prison's "chapel of the good thief."

His work won him a release from Clinton state prison at Dannemora, N. Y., in 1948, with half his term served.

But now Sells is on his way back to prison.

He was sentenced Tuesday to two consecutive terms of 13 to 14 years each for illegal possession of a sub-machine gun and three loaded pistols.

The weapons were found by police last year in a raid on Sells' Manhattan apartment.

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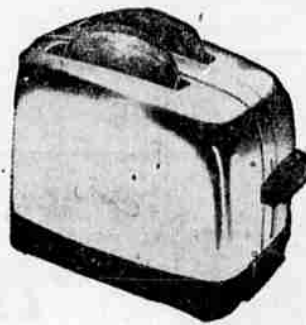
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
