Coast-To-Coast TV Link Expected September 30

NEW YORK — (AP) — The long awaited coast-to-coast television network hookup is expected to go into operation Sept. 30, the American Telephone and Telegraph Co. says.

The big network companies already have announced plans for putting some of their top shows on from Hollywood when the link is completed. It also will permit television viewers on the Pacific coast to see the world series and those in the eastern half of the country to see the Rose Bowl football game.

The basic link will be by way of A. T. and T.'s \$40,000,000 micro-

wave radio-relay system between New York and San Francisco, previously in operation as far as Omaha, Los Angeles and San Francisco already are connected by towers averaging 3 miles apart, which relay sharply focused radio beams from horizon to horizon. The microwave system, longest in the world, will go into coast-to-coast service first for long distance telephone traffic on Friday, Aug. 17. It will practically double the nation's transcontinental communications facilities. It uses 107 towers between New York and San Francisco.

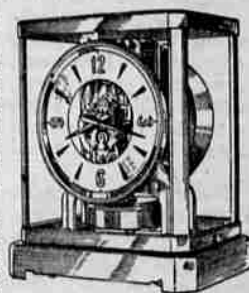
The more familiar underground coaxial cable still will play a major role in the enlarged network, carrying programs to a number of cities from the main coast-to-coast microwave radio relay route.

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
