**Congress Urged To Look For New Taxation Sources**

NEW YORK — (AP) — Congress still has ways to tax you that it hasn't tried yet.

Congress is being urged to look into these ways. The Twentieth Century fund's committee on economic stabilization thinks Congress should start now to study taxes never used here before — just to be ready in case the tightening screws of the income tax and the excise taxes don't raise the billions sought for defense.

The congressional economic committee, at the same time, released a report of its staff experts recommending an immediate tax hike of \$10 billion — with most of the burden on the middle income brackets.

**Escape Of Murderer Costs Guard His Job**

CHICAGO — (AP) — Alleged "laxity" in the big Cook county jail was investigated today as more than 1,000 policemen searched for an armed fugitive who killed a guard and escaped from death row.

"Shoot to kill" orders are out for Harry Williams, 20, six foot, two inch Negro who beat tower guard Arthur Turley to death and scaled the wall to freedom Tuesday night. Williams, a rapist and slayer, was scheduled to be executed Sept. 14.

One guard has already been fired. Edwin T. Breen, first assistant state's attorney, said the escape was "a case of gross negligence and laxity."

**Retailers Want Meat Price Lid Adjusted**

WASHINGTON — (AP) — Retail meat dealers want the ceiling prices of hamburger, chuck, round steaks and beef roasts raised, and ceilings lowered on sirloin steak, and rib and loin roasts.

The Office of Price Stabilization is reviewing the entire beef program. OPS officials said the retail meat dealers want hamburger prices raised three or four cents and suggested a perhaps "substantially" lower price for sirloin steak.
