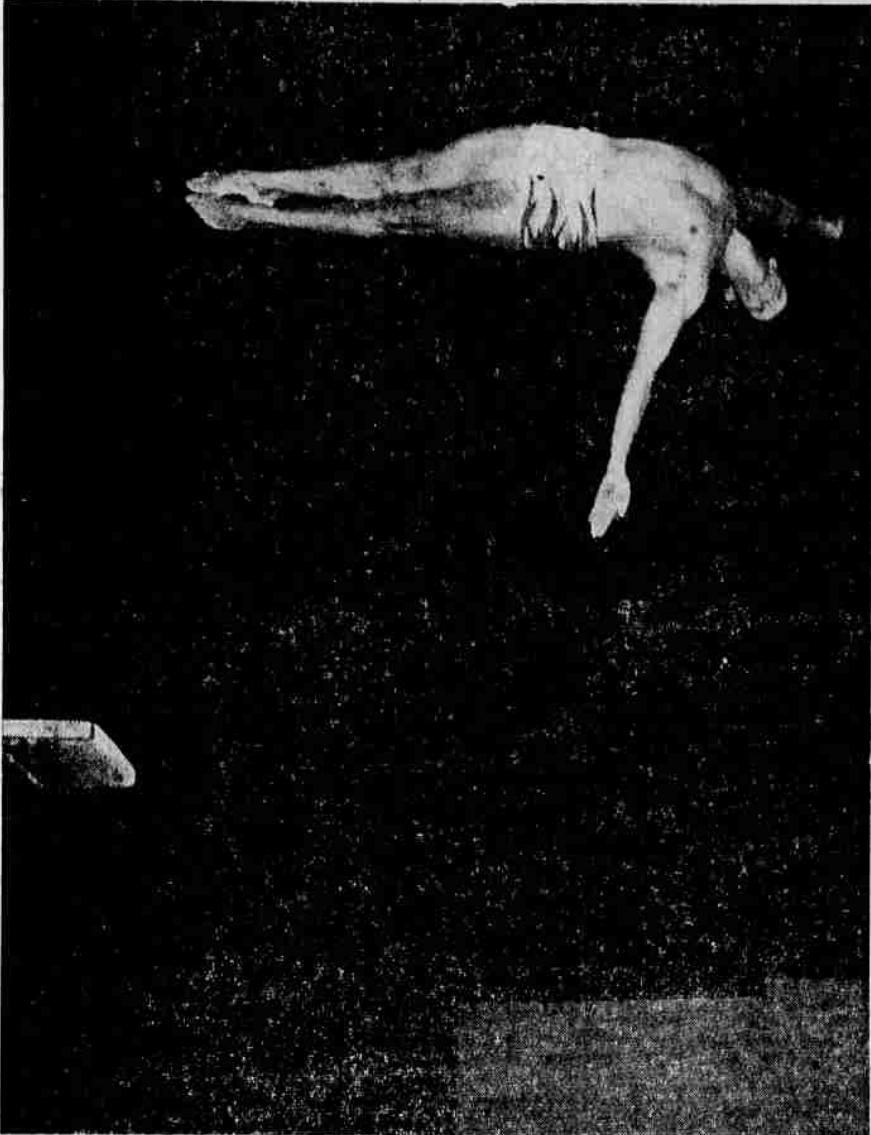


Invitational Swim Meet At Local Pool Highlights Athletic Activity Sunday

Ronney Defferding was winning pitcher in the first game. A sixth inning rally brought the Camas Valley team from behind. Four runs were scored in the sixth by Camas Valley. Marlin Yoder was leading hitter for Camas Valley with three for three. Defferding, Ford Baker and Ernie Fisher each had two for three.

A hit by Cy Defferding in the sixth brought in Yoder with the winning run. Greggs and Starkey

each got two hits for Days Creek and Rechor slammed out a home run.

In the second game Tommy Cantrell pitched winning ball for Camas Valley as they rolled over Associated Plywood 6-3.

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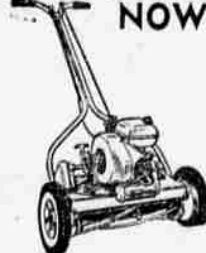
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
