Allies Create New Steel Companies in Germany

BOON, Germany — (AP) — The Western allies have created three new steel companies—one of them the biggest in western Germany—in their program to break up "excessive concentration of economic power."

Occupation authorities for the United States, Britain and France announced yesterday they had set up the Dortmund-Hoerde-Huettenverein combine, which will have a capacity of more than 2,000,000 tons of crude steel annually, and two other smaller companies.

The big company and one of the other new ones received portions of the Vereinigte Stahlwerke (United Steel Works), once Germany's biggest iron and steel concern.

The old concern is being broken up, along with other big iron, coal and steel concerns, in a "trust-busting" program which has been in progress for several years.

The Allies plan to form 24 new steel companies. Thirteen of them will be formed out of the old Vereinigte Stahlwerke. Latest action raised to nine the number already organized.

Man Apparently Dead From Mishap Restored To Life

SPOKANE — (AP) — A man who appeared to be dead after an auto accident near Dayton, Wash., last Friday was brought back to life through the quick action of a group of power company linemen.

The story was told by the accident victim himself, Joe P. Simpson of Spokane, and Tom Keenan of Dayton, district manager of the Pacific Power and Light company.

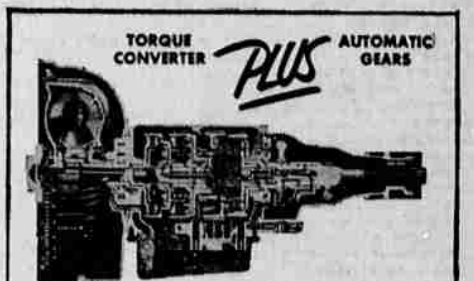
Keenan said lineman Bob Dupree of Walsburg spotted the accident from where he was working atop a power pole. By the time Keenan and four fellow workers had pulled Simpson out of the wrecked car, he had stopped breathing and they could find no pulse.

Afraid to move the injured man, Dolph Brown, crew foreman, gave him artificial respiration by massaging his stomach. In ten minutes Simpson began breathing again.

"My doctor told me I wouldn't be here today if it were not for the fast action of those men," Simpson said. "I am unbelievably lucky."
